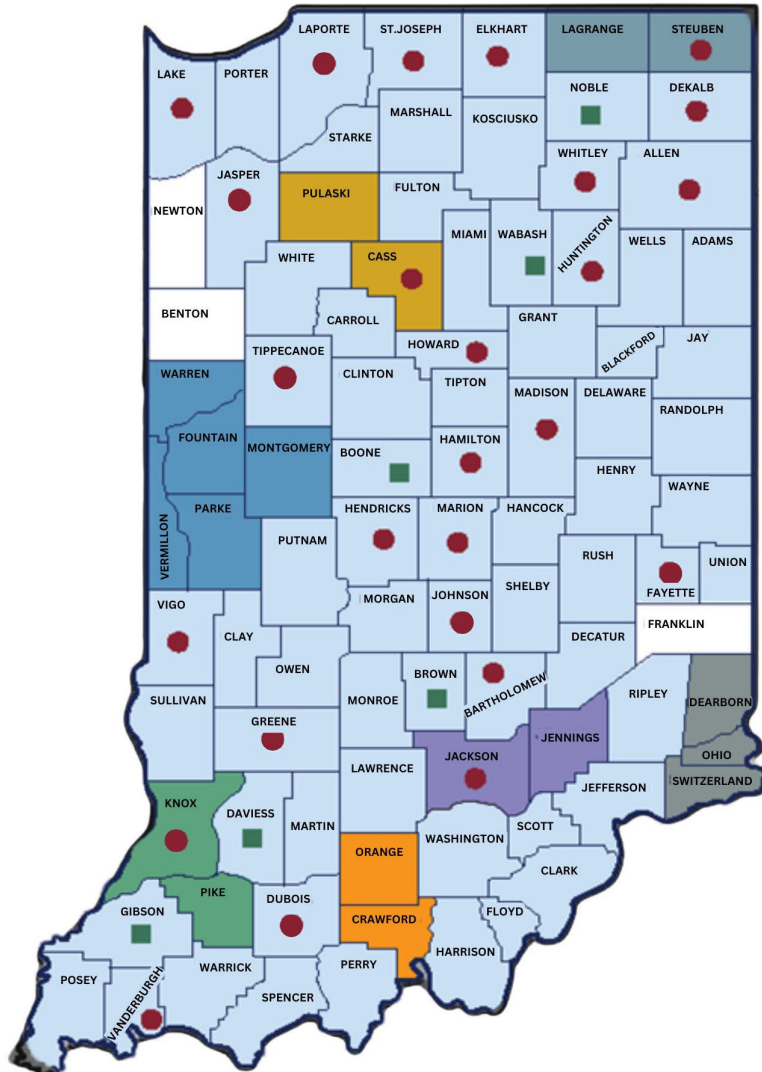
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Adult Population Trends

- Aging and Physical Health



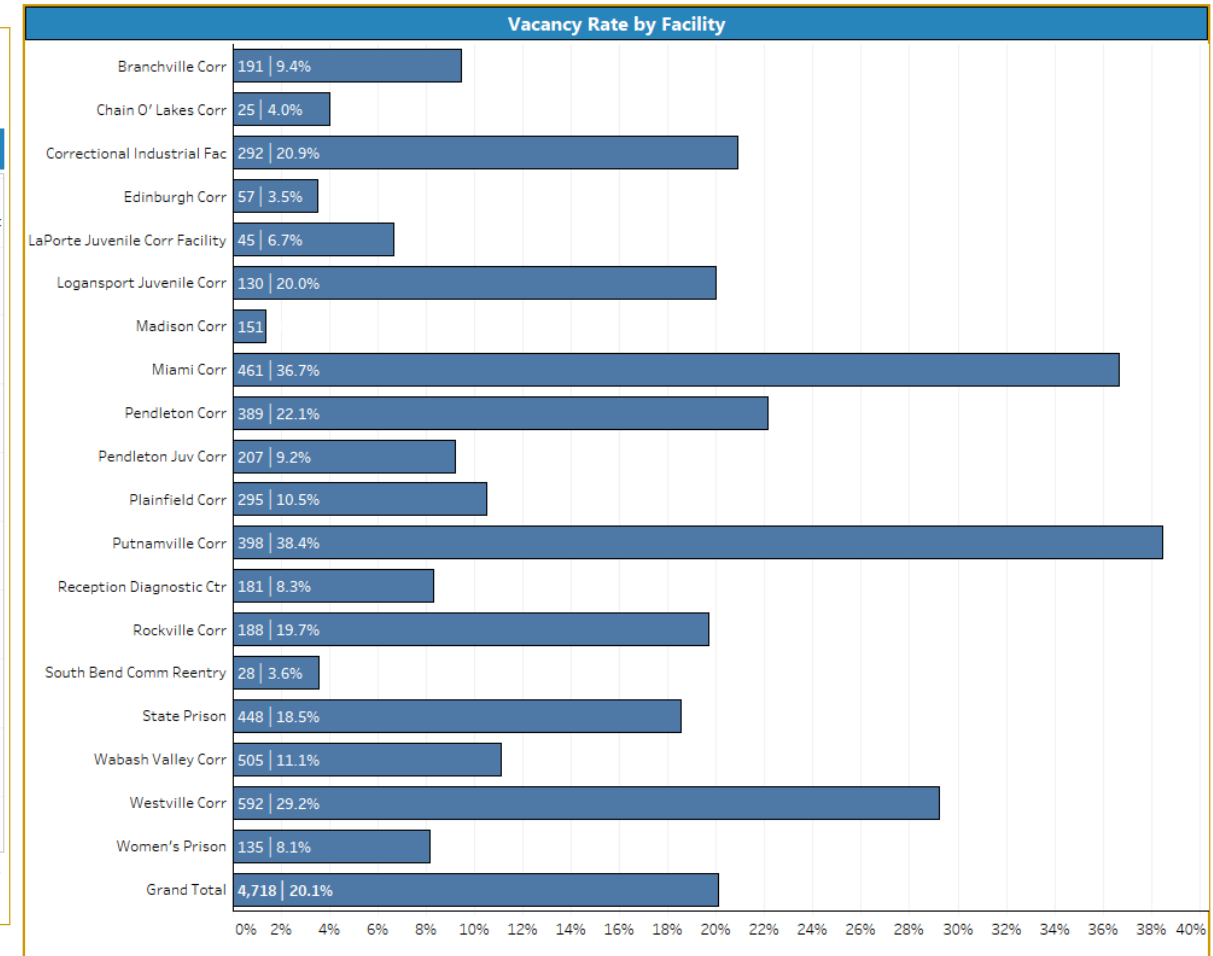
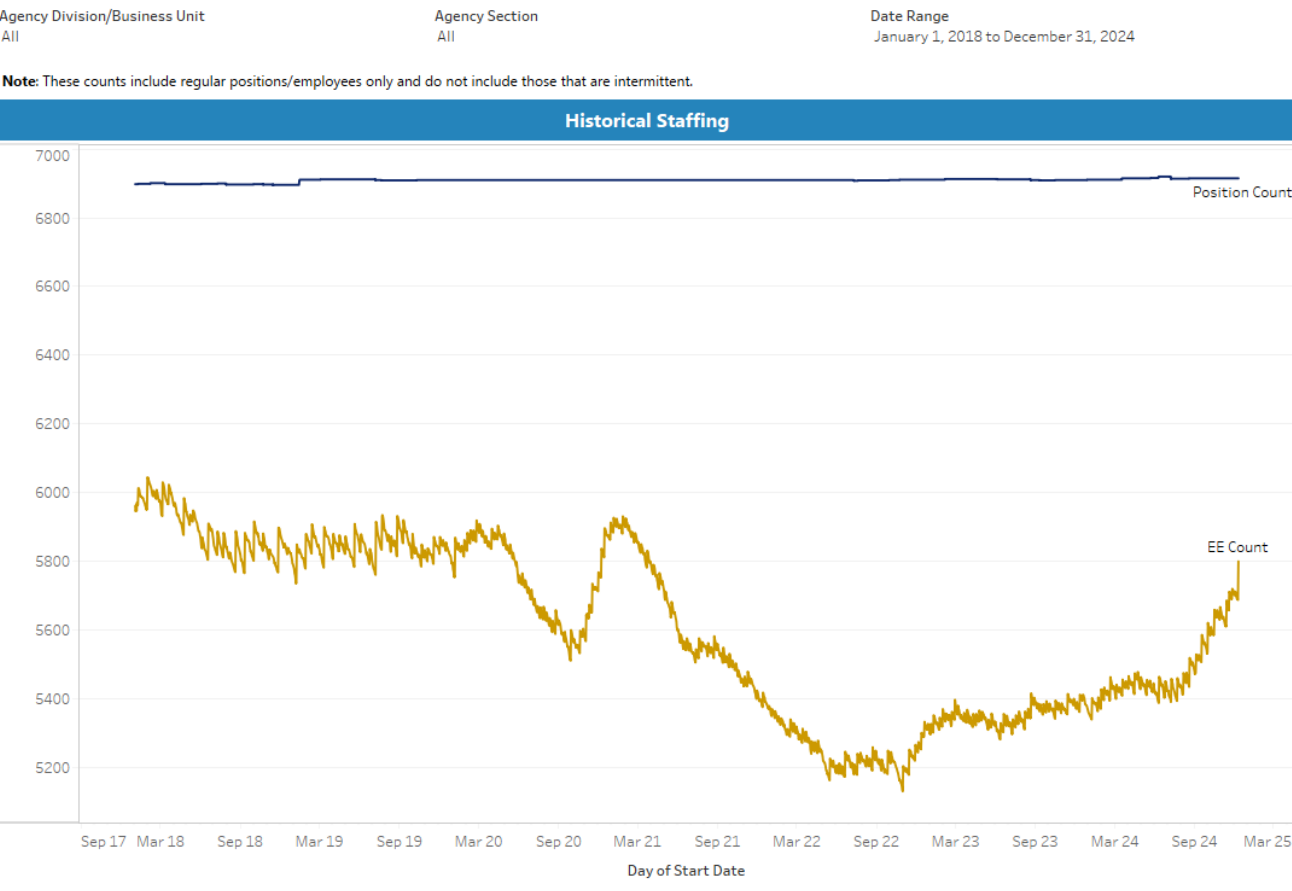
Community Corrections/Justice Reinvestment Grants



- \$72.5M in grants to over 200 grant funded entities and 89 counties statewide
- New proposal to amend the community corrections fund distribution formula set forth in 210 IAC 2-1-3 was developed by a committee of representatives from IDOC, SBA, IACCAC, POPAI
 - Better accounts for variables including county population, age range, arrests, admissions and dispositions, per capita of next taxable, and available work release programs
 - Next step will be to move forward with the formal rulemaking process

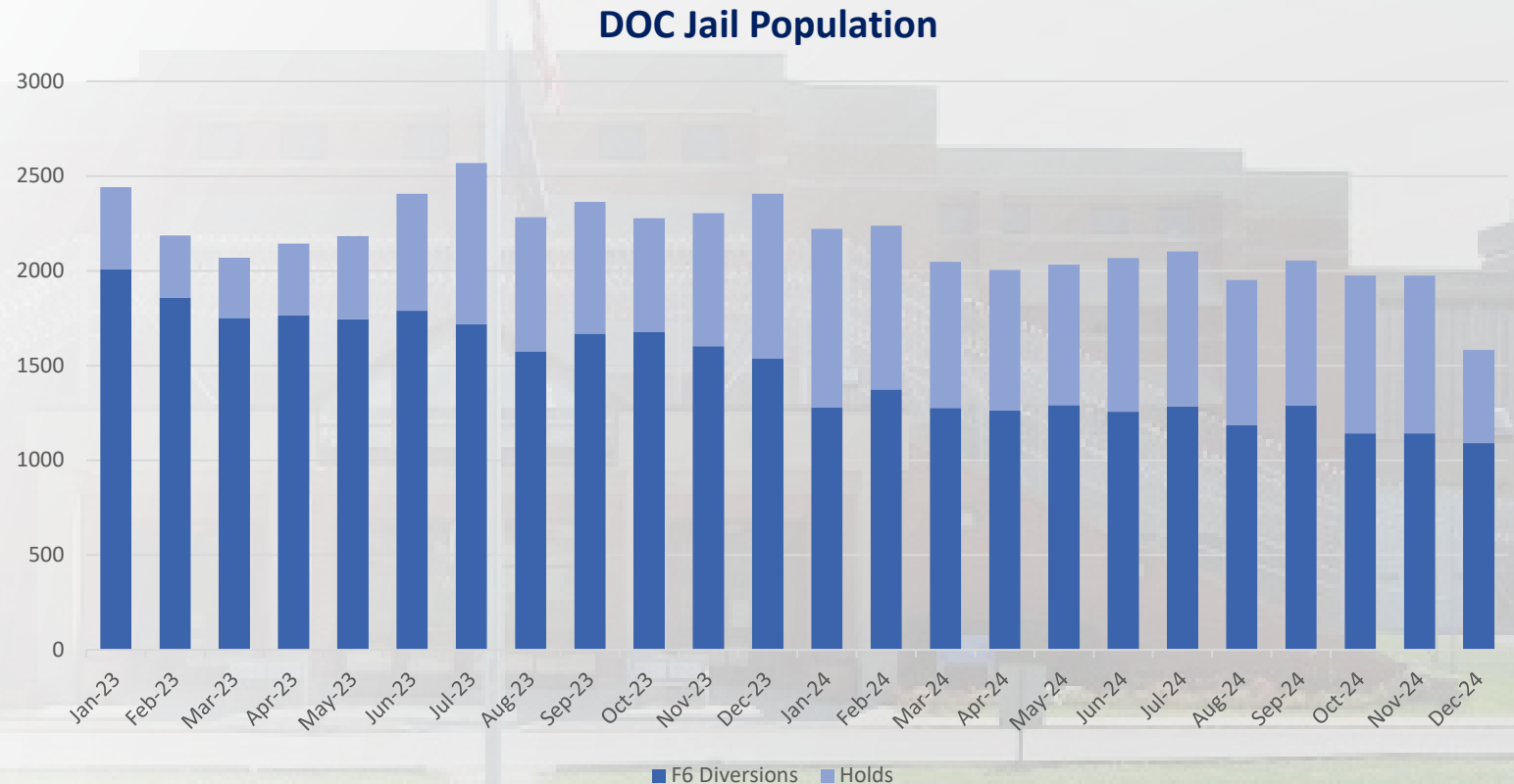
