



## Frequently Asked Questions AmpliFund Webinar

Update: October 7, 2025

- **Is AmpliFund a module of EUNA Grants (formerly eCivis)?**
  - No. EUNA Solutions purchased AmpliFund, the company, in May of 2025.
- **Will we need to implement both Grant Seeker and Grant Maker functionality of AmpliFund?**
  - No. We are staying on the EUNA Grants grantee module. We are only implementing the Grantmaker functionality of AmpliFund.
- **When will my agency move to, or implement, AmpliFund Grant Maker.**
  - We are starting with INDOT, ICJI, and DHS. SBA will put forth a schedule for the remaining agencies with pass-through funding once the timeline has been determined.
- **Will we have to manually enter the solicitations and applications that are in EUNA Grants now in AmpliFund?**
  - They will be rebuilt in AmpliFund. SBA will provide more information as this scope gets finalized with EUNA Solutions.
- **Will SBA help us set up the solicitations in AmpliFund?**
  - Yes. If the information was previously in EUNA Grants, it will be rebuilt in AmpliFund. SBA will provide more information as this scope gets finalized with EUNA Solutions.
- **How does SBA intend on supporting this transition with agencies that do not have the time or personnel capable of doing so?**
  - SBA will continue to assist in implementation activities as well as internal and external communications and training needs. We can discuss the needs of a specific agency during their transition planning phase. It is important to remember that this implementation is required by [FMC 4.1](#) and supported by a legislative initiative.
- **Is this inclusive of agency-to-agency awards/grants? Or just agency to outside organization awards?**
  - At this time, all substate transfers will continue to be processed through the **EUNA Grants grantee module**. As part of the upcoming discovery process with ICJI, IDHS,

and INDOT, we will explore how these processes, including agency-to-agency transfers, could be supported within the **AmpliFund module**.

- **Would FMC 4.1 Section 8 still apply for agencies that may seek a Waiver?**
  - **No.** The waiver process has fulfilled its intended purpose of addressing agency-specific business requirements. As such, **FMC 4.1 Section 8 no longer applies** to agencies pursuing a waiver. However, the SBA continues to welcome agencies to present any **additional needs or requests for system enhancements** to ensure the selected solution remains responsive and adaptable to evolving requirements.
- **Can existing grantor programs stay in eCivis until they are closed out?**
  - Yes. Agencies will be able to stay in Euna Grants through closeout of the grant programs that are in the middle of the period of performance.
- **Is the implementation of AmpliFund only for grant programs funded by federal awards?**
  - No. This is for both State and Federal grants.
- **When will my agency transition/implement AmpliFund?**
  - SBA will provide a roadmap with more information regarding the implementation plan for all agencies that have pass-through funding once defined.
