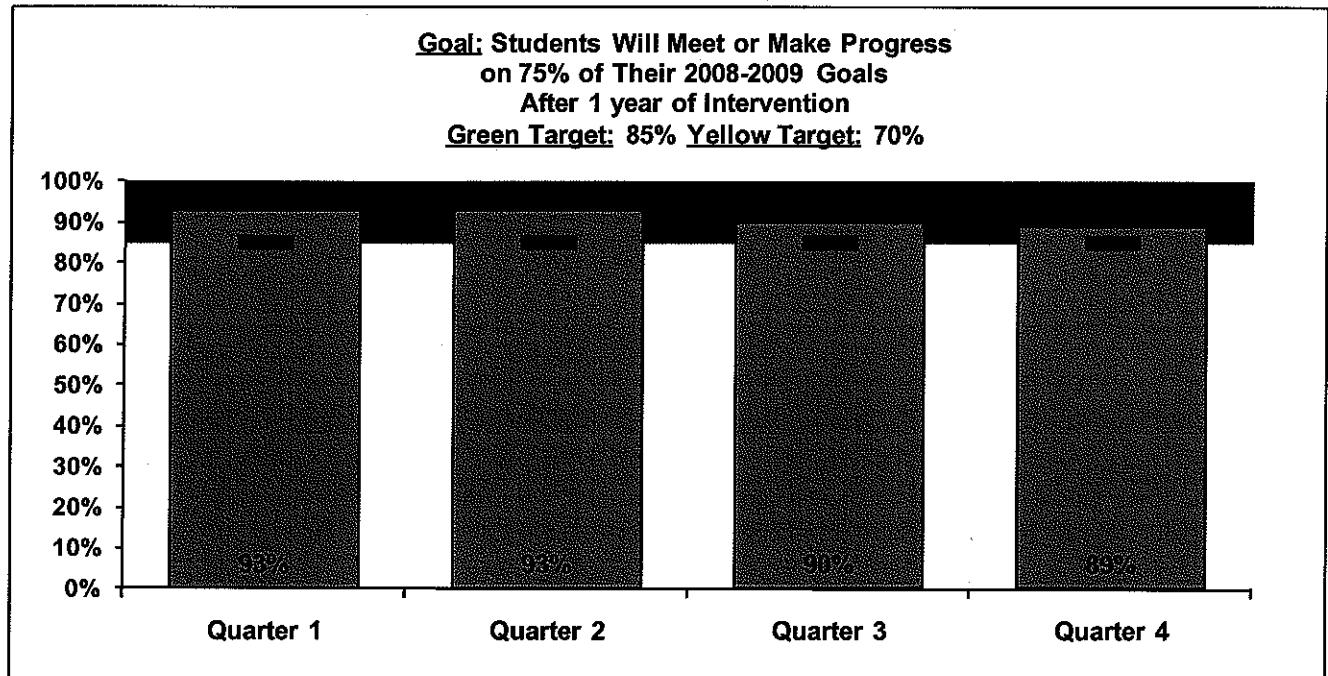

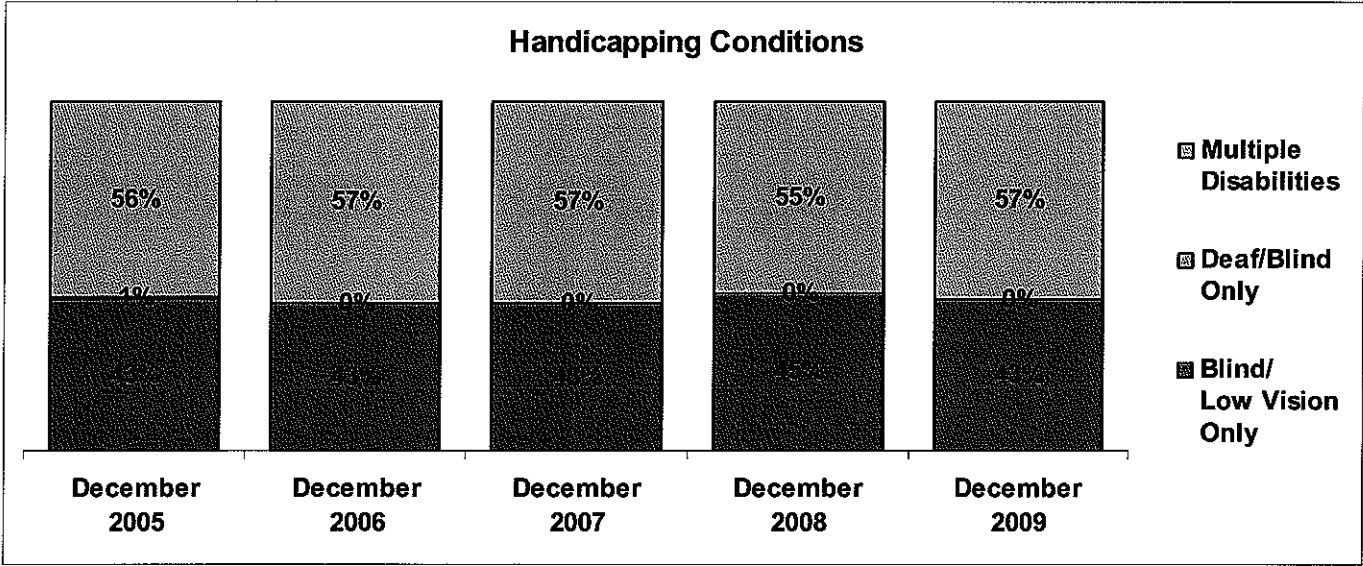
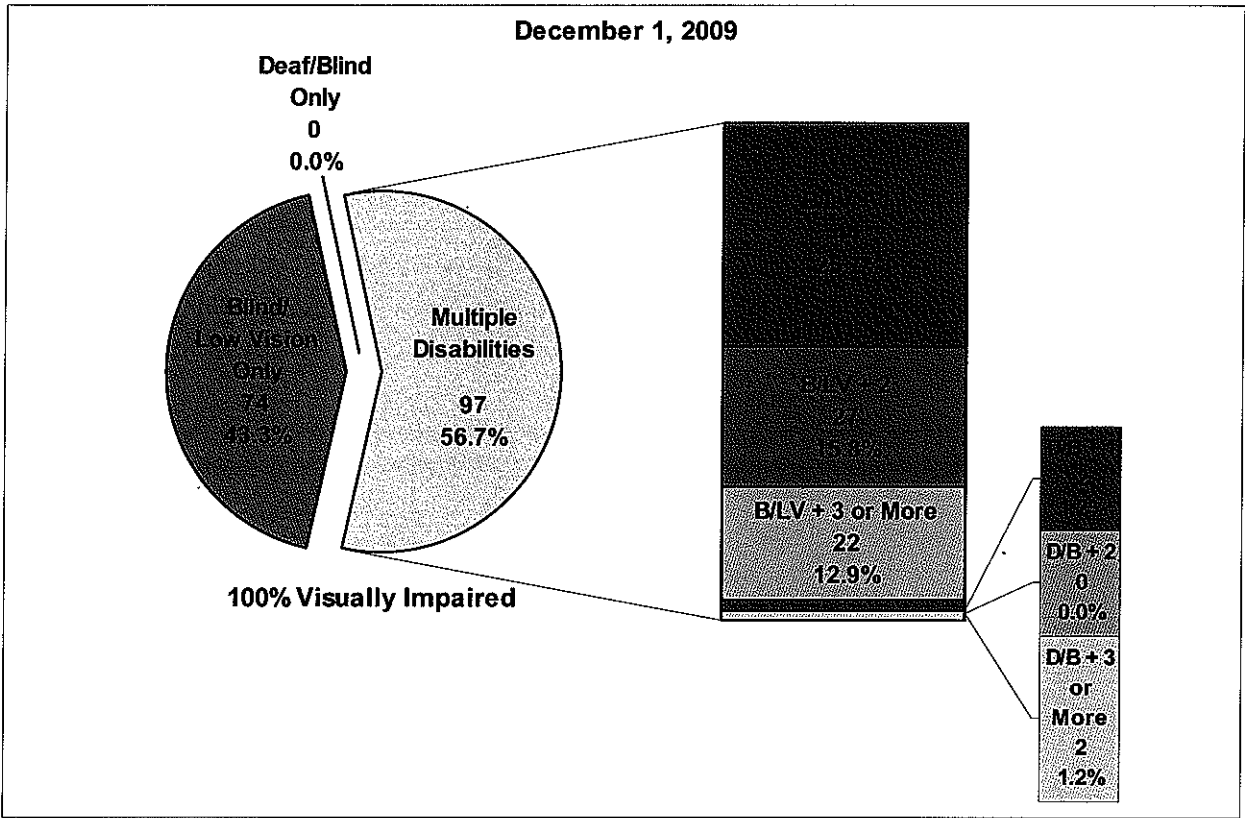
Individual Education Plan (IEP) Data – Measuring Effectiveness of Interventions

- Quarters are determined by the ISBVI school year calendar

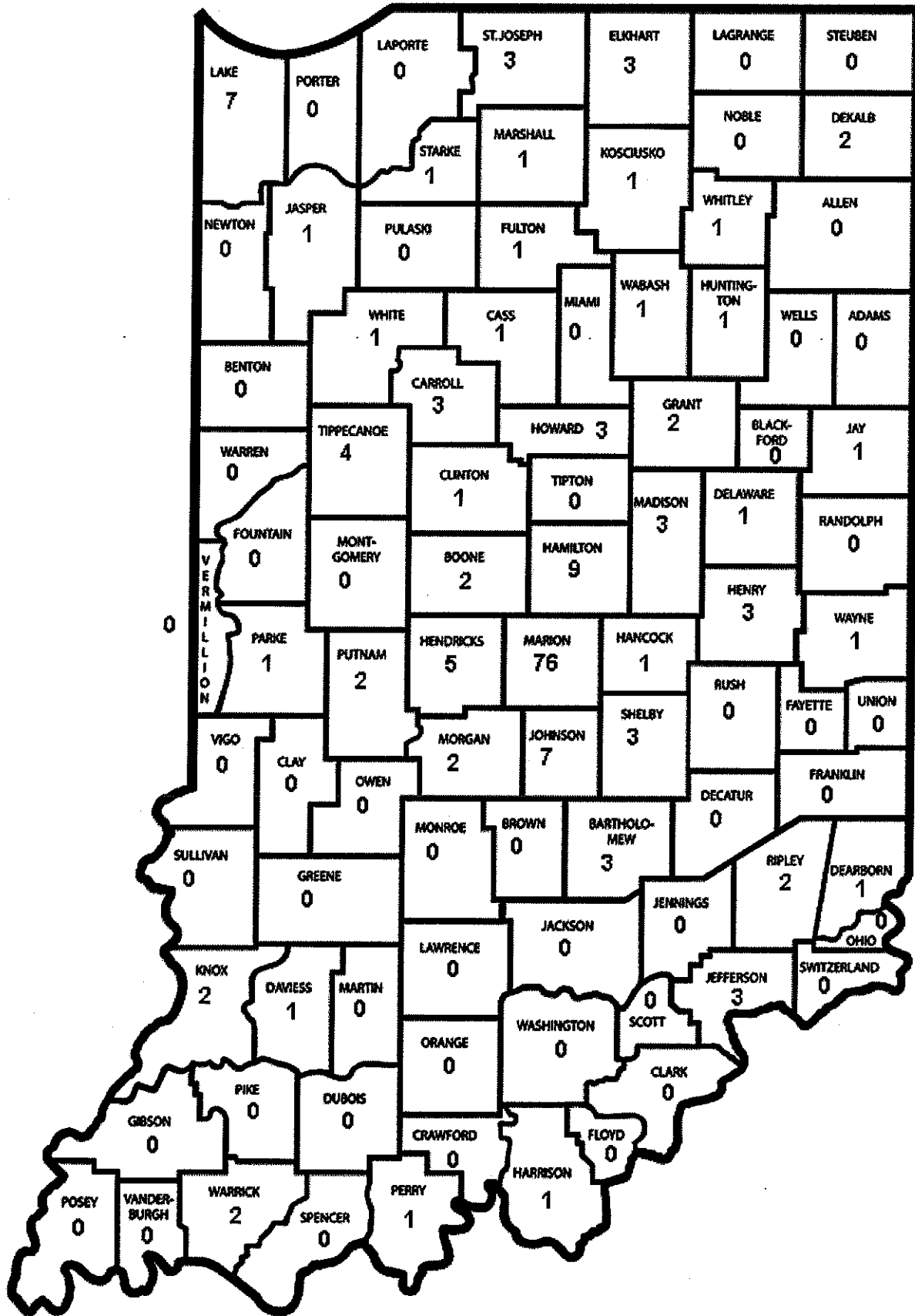

Goal met Q1, Q2, & Q3 by Elementary students





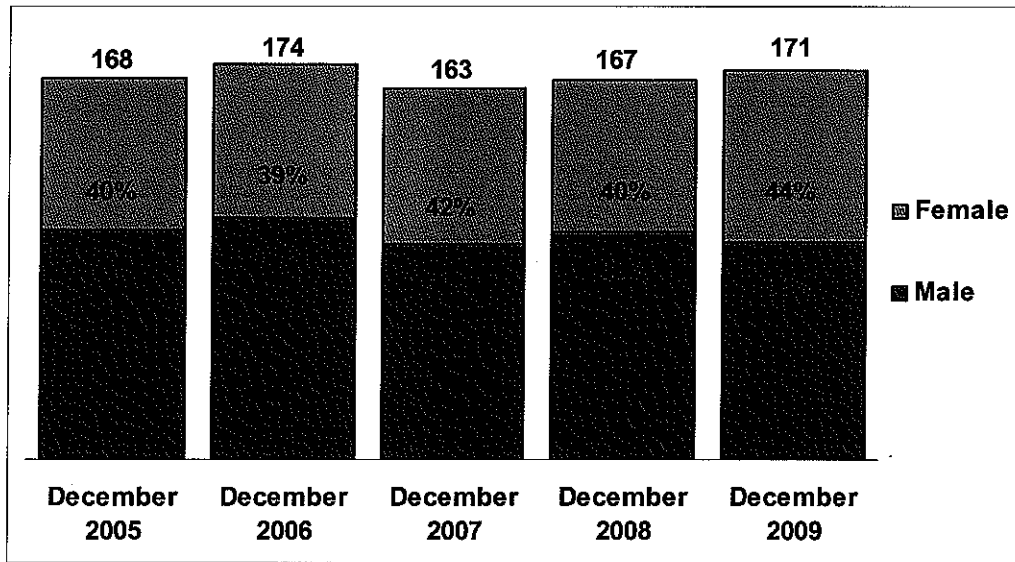
County of Residence - December 2009



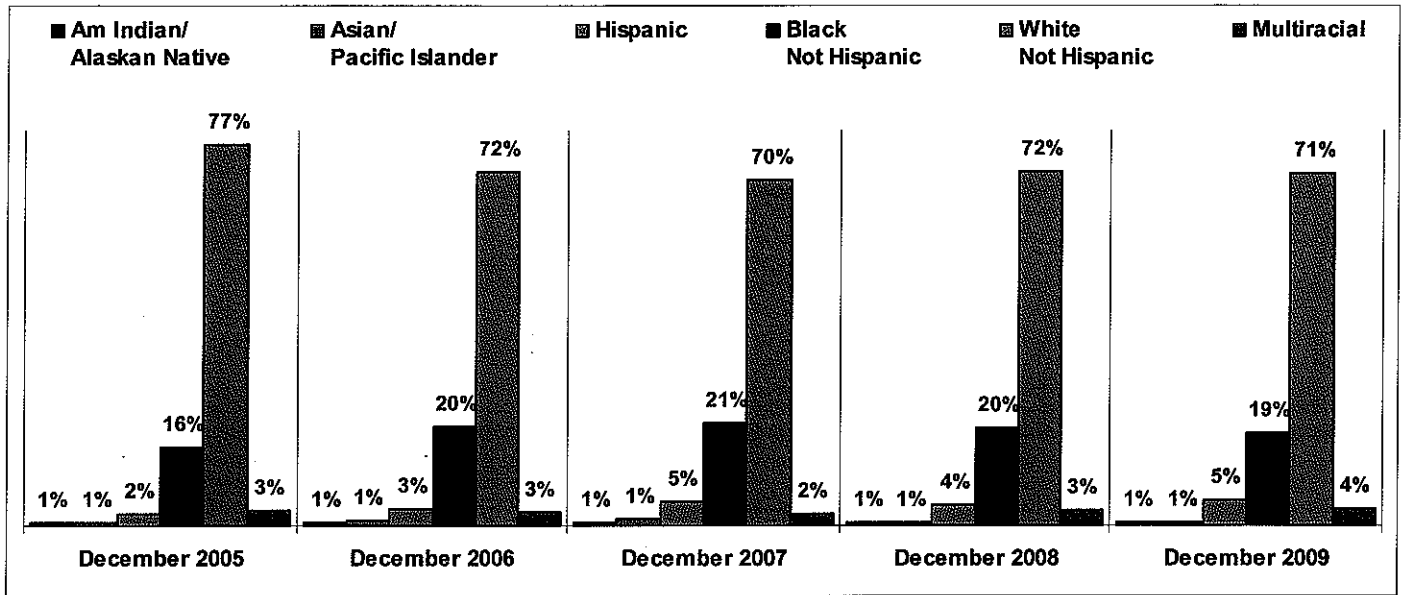

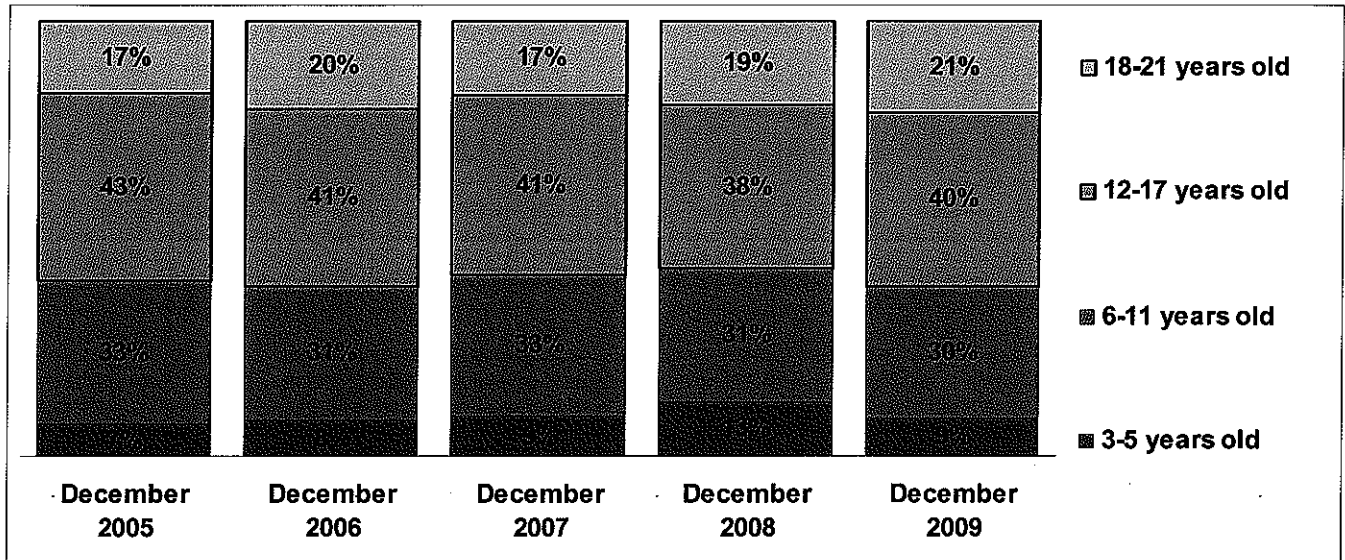
Gender and Number of Students
