



Estimated Student Fees






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








Student Transfers





The national average for all states was 45%



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




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


Ivy Tech Appropriations per FTE Student



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
Ivy Tech Appropriations per FTE Student






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Total Gap in funding FTE basis (in millions)





- ✓ Lowest cost provider




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Students Needing Remediation

Limited Student Support

- Total fall 2012 first day enrollment = 107,973 students
- ✓ Total academic advisors = 150
- ✓ Ratio actual = 1 to 720
- ✓ Ratio goal = 1 to 250



Advising is key for degree completion, even more important with students needing remediation.



Living with Limited Resources

- Despite increasing number of students needing remediation both tradition and nontraditional students
- ✓ Despite decreased funding
- ✓ Able to keep success measures consistent as opposed to decrease
- ✓ Co-requisite pilots showing promise

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


