Indiana State Department of Health

Supplemental Funding: \$200 million

- -Testing
 - Specimen processing
 - Equipment, supplies, operations of testing sites and labs
 - Specimen collections
 - Grants to local health departments to expand testing network
 - Cleaning, sanitizing
 - Data management and analysis
- -Contract Tracing

- Family and Social Services Administration
 - Supplemental Funding: approximately \$150 million
 - Residential and Home Health Provider Covid Expense Assistance \$38 million
 - Approximately 125 intermediate care facilities and home/community-based service and over 200 home health potential providers
 - -Nursing Facilities-\$83 million financial support through public health emergency or December 30
 - -Safe Recovery Sites-\$12 million
 - -Operational costs-\$15 million

 Supplemental Funding – \$25 million

Workforce Ready Grant

- 6,756 enrollments in WRG eligible programs
 - 3,422 at Ivy Tech
 - 2,749 through 3rd party provider
 - 585 at VU
- 3,300 completions
 - 2,562 at Ivy Tech
 - 444 through 3rd party provider
 - 981 at VU



Workforce Cabinet

Employer Training Grant (state appropriation and Relief Fund)

- 720 employers with active agreements
- 10,661 trainees
- 4,382 new hires
- 147 employers from xBE company

MOU Program Additions and Updates

- Indiana Economic Development Corporation
 - Supplemental Funding: \$44 million
 - **PPE Marketplace**
 - Over 57 million pieces procured
 - 16 Indiana vendors producing or manufacturing PPE
 - Over 33,000 deliveries to Indiana small businesses and nonprofits through the marketplace
 - 588 schools received two deliveries of disposable masks, reusable masks, and hand sanitizer
 - Indiana Department of Health has distributed over 6 million pieces of PPE to healthcare organizations

Small Business Restart Program

- 299 grants totaling \$1.2 million
- 163 XBE grants totaling \$.222 million



- Indiana Department of Child Services
 - Provider Grant Assistance \$11 million
 - Child placement agencies, community-based and residential providers
 - Medical, public health and other COVID-19 related expenses incurred while providing child welfare services
 - Applications due November 5
- Indiana Department of Agriculture
 - Meat Processing Development Grant \$4 million
 - Applications due October 21; 26 submitted to date and 40 in process

MOU Updates

- Indiana Finance Authority
 Local Government Support
 - \$85 million reimbursements approved
 - \$44 million for 1,110 claims paid
 - 221 unique participants
 - 13 days average process time

MOU Updates

- Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority Rental Assistance Fund
 - \$24.5 million paid to landlords
 - Recently opened Emergency Solutions Grant for rent assistance

- Indiana Destination Development Corporation
 Arts and Cultural Event Grants
 - 439 Arts, Cultural, and Festival organizations awarded \$8,554,111
 - 40 Destination Marketing Organizations awarded \$1,317,856
