CARES Act Coronavirus Relief Fund, \$2.4 billion

- Eligible costs incurred March 1, 2020, through December 31, 2021
- Close-out preparation continues
 - Identifying obligation residuals
 - Remaining and developing costs
 - Disposition



NEU Distribution as of October 2021

- 485 of 543 eligible NEUs have applied
- \$213.7 million of the first 50%, \$216.3 million, has been distributed
- First Project and Expenditure Report has been rescheduled to April 30, 2022, for activity through March 31, 2022

ARP - Selected Program Updates

- UI Trust Fund Restoration
 - Replenishment payment processed this week
- Public Safety Equipment
 - 765 body-worn and in-car cameras deployed (ISP)
 - Stab vest procurement process initiated (DOC)
- Public Safety Premium Pay
 - Almost 1,300 ISP troopers and capitol police paid in August
 - Over 4,700 DOC staff paid in early October



ARP - Selected Program Updates

- Career Accelerator
 - 38 programs applications received; 11 approved
- Regional Economic Advancement and Development Initiative
 - 17 applicants representing entire state
- Water and Sewer
 - Almost 500 applicants, requests exceeding \$700 million
 - Awards in late September
- Broadband
 - More than 250 letters of intent requesting over \$600 million
 - Reviewing Capital Projects Fund guidance



US Treasury Updates

- Project and Expenditure Report now due January 31, 2022, for activity through December 31, 2021
- NEU distribution updates to be filed monthly; remaining NEUs will be deemed "non-responsive"
- Pending rule finalization
