







# Adult Facility Map by Security Levels





## **Juvenile Facility Map**






## **Indiana Parole Districts**






# Number of Incarcerated Adults Sentenced to DOC



## **Community Corrections Population Snapshot Trend**


Pre-Trial Felons Misdemeanants






## **2020 Community Corrections Agencies**

- Cohort-style intake process

### Reduced/Suspended

- Offender movement
  - Rescheduled non-emergency offsite medical trips
  - Suspended non-emergency interfacility transfers
  - Limited intra-facility movement
- Industries jobs within the facility
- Off-site work crews and work release
- Staff meetings, non-essential staff training and audits
- In-person offender programming and group services
- Offender visitation
- Volunteer services
- In-person attorney visits
- Shelter placement for releasing offenders
