Incentives

ENHANCING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TOOLS

Innovation Vouchers

Provides grants to small businesses that partner with Indiana universities for activities like research, technology development, or commercialization

Headquarters Relocation Tax Credit

Better incentivizes the relocation of small, high-growth companies

Venture Capital Investment Tax Credit

Increases the pool of potential investors to high-growth, early-stage companies by making the tax credit transferable starting in 2020

Data Center Tax ExemptionsProvides local property and state sales tax exemptions for large-scale data centers constructed in Indiana with a significant capital investment

Redevelopment Tax Credit

Enhances the former Industrial Recovery (DINO) tax credit program, further incentivizing investments to redevelop communities and improve quality of place

Hoosier Business Investment Tax Credit

Expands qualified investment to capture modernized equipment used in today's manufacturing and logistics sectors






