The Euna Grants Update: Getting Grants in Euna Grants

Euna Grants is the State of Indiana's new state-wide grants management system

State agencies will build grant solicitations in Euna Grants.

Grant applicants will access solicitations via the State Budget Agency website or a private link.

Applications will be submitted electronically through the Euna Grants Portal.

Grant recipients will receive their award notice via Euna Grants.

Recipients will use Euna Grants to submit activity reports, request reimbursement, and conduct grant close-out activities.

Login page where grant recipients will access the Portal.

Getting set up in the Euna Grants Portal is easy!

First time Euna Grants users will setup a Grants Portal account and profile.


New Account setup requires a name, email, and password. There is no cost to set up a Grants Portal account.

After logging into the Grants Portal, users can add information to build-out their user profile, including organization-specific information like name, address, website, UEI number, etc.

Applicants will use the Euna Grants Portal to submit their applications. The online process is as simple as buying off Amazon. Applicants will enter text into fields, select from drop-down lists, click “all that apply” buttons, and upload documents. It is the same information applicants have always included in their applications, just a different way of submitting the information. The Grants Portal is also where successful applicants will manage their awards.

What happens during a State Budget Agency Office Hour?

- Brief introduction of topic to be demonstrated and ask any burning questions - 5 minutes
- Demonstrations led by SBA Grants Team staff - 30 minutes

- Closing remarks, reminders of next training - 5 minutes

When are the State Budget Agency Office Hours?

- State Budget Agency hosts Office Hours for applicants, subrecipients, and state grant recipients.
- REMEMBER. For Euna Grants purposes “subrecipients” and “state grant recipients” are synonymous.
- Applicant/Subrecipient Office Hours are the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month from 1:00-2:00pm Eastern.
- Each Office Hours has a prescheduled topic for demonstration by State Budget Agency grants staff.
