



Subrecipient FAQ

- **Is Euna Grants the new eCivis?**
 - Yes, eCivis has rebranded themselves as Euna Grants. Same company, but a different name
- **Where do I go to create a Euna Grants (formerly eCivis) Portal account?**
 - <https://portal.ecivis.com/#/login>
- **Is there a charge for creating a Euna Grants (formerly eCivis) Portal account?**
 - No, there is no charge. Portal accounts are free.
- **Can you create more than one Portal account for your organization?**
 - Yes, you can create as many accounts as necessary to help manage your grant.
- **When logging into the Euna Grants (formerly eCivis) Portal, should I choose “Portal Login” or “Grants Network Login”?**
 - The Portal Login is for non-state employees
 - The Grants Network Login is for state employees
- **I have a Euna Grants (formerly eCivis) Portal account, but when I login I don’t see the application for the grant I wish to apply for.**
 - You need to click on the Apply button from the solicitation webpage to have access to application.
 - Once successfully logged into the Portal, click the Create New Application button to access the application.
- **What if I can’t find the grant opportunity on the State Budget Agency website?**
 - The state budget agency website only lists the “public” solicitations. Private solicitations will be sent directly to approved candidates. Please contact the Granting Agency for further information.
- **Can you have more than one person working on the grant in the Euna Grants (formerly eCivis) portal?**
 - Yes, the owner of the workspace (whoever submitted the application) can invite other to join the workspace by clicking on the “Manage Project Team” button from the Award Dashboard.

- **Does each person with access to the Grant Awarded workspace have equal access and abilities?**
 - Yes, each person with access to the grant workspace can perform any functions necessary to manage the grant.
- **What if I submitted my application but need to make changes?**
 - Once your application has been submitted, you need to contact the State Granting Agency to see if they will allow changes to be made after submission.
- **Are financial reports and reimbursement requests the same thing?**
 - Yes, submitting financial reports in Euna Grants (formerly eCivis) is the same as submitting a reimbursement request. You will click on the reimbursement button on the request letting the granting agency know this is for financial reimbursement.
- **Can I track reimbursement requests in the Euna Grants (formerly eCivis) portal?**
 - Yes, you will be able to see all financial requests and their current status when submitting financial reports.
- **Will I be notified when activities are due or completed in the Euna Grants (formerly eCivis) portal?**
 - Yes, you and any added team members will receive automatic email messages from Euna Grants (formerly eCivis) about upcoming requirements or completed actions.
- **Who should I contact if I am having problems?**
