Digitizing Floodplain Mapping

DNR has jurisdiction over construction, excavation, and fill activities that occur within the floodway of rivers, streams, and waterways throughout the state. Floodplain maps are used by DNR to review permit applications for these activities and completion of a technical assessment as to whether or not a project will adversely affect the efficiency or capacity of a floodway or pose an unreasonable threat to the safety of life or property. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) publishes floodway maps. Although currently available in paper form, FEMA is in the process of converting the maps into a digital format for ease of use and distribution. To digitize these maps, FEMA has quoted a price of \$100,000 per county. There are approximately 82 counties left, for a total cost of \$8.2 million. Prison Enterprise Network (PEN), through Resource Mapping Incorporated, has given an estimate of \$180,000 to \$200,000 for digitizing 82 counties in Indiana (the other 10 have already been scheduled for completion by FEMA). This request is for a pilot project with PEN to have half of the counties digitized at a cost of \$99,000.

Asbestos Removal Project No. B18-910

The ISSCH must replace the existing steam condensate piping from the school, running through the Chapel and then to the Administration Building. Unacceptable levels of asbestos have been discovered in the process. The asbestos fiber is a result of pipe insulation that was removed several years ago, with proper encapsulation taking place at that time. However, the encapsulation has worn down. Because the current project will involve a 5' X 12' area of excavation, it has been determined that additional steps must be taken to contain the asbestos fibers. The area must be cleaned up and the dirt floor encapsulated with a rubber based spray-on product. The Bypass Valves project should be completed by the end of September 2002.
