II. Agency Projects

1. Department of Administration (061) \$696,640
Logistic Support Center Roofing Project

The Department of Administration requests to proceed with a roof replacement project at the Logistic Support Center located on East 30th Street in Indianapolis. The current rubber and ballasted roofing system has surpassed its useful life and is beginning to leak due to the deteriorated rubber membrane separating from the flashing and seams. The project will consist of removing and replacing the current roofing system along with the underlying insulation. The replacement roof will have a 20-year warranty and will allow the Department of Administration to apply maintenance coats to extend the life of the asset beyond the warranty period. Currently, the Logistic Support Center houses the ATC Excise Police district office, BMV warehouse, INDOT operations, Records Center, and State Archives.

Repair and Rehabilitation

2. Department of Transportation (800) \$6,850,000
Fort Wayne Administration Building

The Department of Transportation (INDOT) requests approval to proceed with the construction of the Fort Wayne Administration Building. The current Fort Wayne Administration Building was constructed in 1976. This building is significantly undersized and does not meet INDOT's current and future operational needs. It is outdated, in need of significant repair, operationally inefficient, and does not comply with the current American with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. This building is the last of the six district administration buildings to be replaced.

3. Department of Transportation (800) \$2,785,583
Various Repair Projects

The Department of Transportation (INDOT) requests approval to proceed with various maintenance projects across their 400 facilities. This request will fund various preventive maintenance and repair and rehabilitation projects under \$250,000.




