The election division will work with the BMV to get dates of birth for these individuals and provide a list to the county. IC 3-7-38.2-4 Commercial data will be used to identify voters whose addresses may have changed. Counties will be able to send SAMCs to these voters starting in IC 3-7-38.2-2 I IC 3-7-38.2-7.1 SVRS will now identify all (not just new) potential non-residential addresses.
