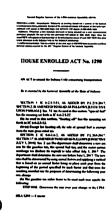
Annual Operational Report:

- Required by Indiana Code 8-17-4.1
- Disclose information to reflect the <u>financial condition</u> and <u>operations</u> of a county highway or city/town street department
- We will refer to it as "Report" for this presentation

<u>CURRENT</u> Requirement per Indiana Code



Indiana Code 8-17-4.1 contains the following:

- **4.1-1** Report to be completed by all counties and municipalities with populations of at least 20,000
- **4.1-5** Prepared by April 15
- **4.1-7** Filed by June 1
- 4.1-8 SBOA provides a list to Auditor of State of counties and cities/towns that have not filed the report. AOS "shall withhold" the distribution of MVH monies

CHANGES in Legislation



House Bill 1290

 Changed SBOA reporting to AOS

from March 1 to June 15

(effective January 1, 2018)

SECTION 29. IC 8-17-4.1-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2018 (RETROACTIVE)]: Sec. 8. (a) On March + June 15 following the operational report year, the state board of accounts shall prepare a certified list of counties and municipalities that have not complied with this chapter.

(b) The state board of accounts shall immediately apprise the auditor of state when the certified list described in subsection (a) is initially certified or revised for an operational report year.

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Importance of the Report



- 1. To ensure your MVH distributions are not withheld
- 2. INDOT uses Report for federal reporting can impact grant funding to counties
- 3. Increases transparency will demonstrate compliance with 50% restriction in future
- 4. Provide information to citizens, legislators, media, etc.

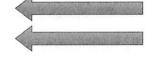

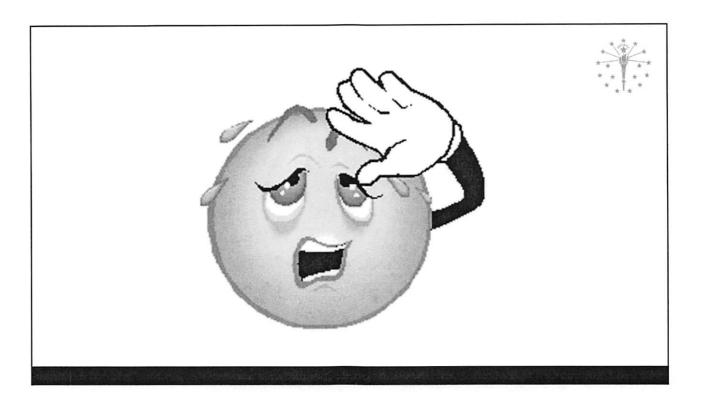

Changes in Legislation



House Bill 1290

 Changes population requirement for cities and towns from 20,000 to 15,000

(effective July 1, 2018)

SECTION 28. IC 8-17-4.1-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018]: Sec. 1. (a) This chapter

- (1) all counties; and
- (2) municipalities with a population of at least twenty fifteen thousand (20,000): (15,000).

Changes in Legislation – <u>FUTURE</u> Reporting



House Bill 1290:

Effective July 1, 2018:

- Removes "maintenance" inserts "preservation" "... the county shall use at least 50% of the money for the
 - "... the county shall use at least 50% of the money for the construction, reconstruction, and <u>preservation</u> of ... highways."
- Defines "preservation" in Indiana Code 8-14-1-1(7)

Changes in Legislation (continued)



(7) The term "preservation" means the preventative treatment, nonstructural treatment, rehabilitation, or structural repairs made to transportation infrastructure and related drainage that are included in an asset management plan approved by the Indiana department of transportation in collaboration with the local technical assistance program at Purdue University.

<u>FUTURE</u> Report Changes – for 2019



Reasons:

- Indiana Code 8-14-1-5 ----- 50% restriction
- SBOA reintroduced forms to document cost allocation
- Local officials wanted the Report to show compliance with 50%
- Committee was formed:
 - > SBOA, LTAP, INDOT, Associations, Street & highway representatives

Instructions added to spreadsheet and no longer a separate document:

Financial statement information, including beginning and ending cash balances, for the most common funds reported by LPA's are included in the first four columns of Receipts and disbursements for other less common funds used for read, street, and bridge expenses are reported in the "Other Funds" column. The "Total All Funds" then be the grant total of all finals reserved from all sources and used by the agency for read, street, and bridge separes.

The common funds included in Section 1 are Motor Vehicle Highway, Local Road and Street, and the Commissive Bridge Fund. The Commissive Bridge Fund to Counter will apply out to countes. Examples of less common funds used by some LPA's may include that are not limited 10). Generally, the information contained on Section 1 will be compiled from the funds ledger. The Section 1 will show the beginning balance of cash at January 1 for cemmon funds, receipt statis for all sources for all funds, distoursement totals for each classification for all funds, and the ending cash and Investment balance at December 31 for common funds for the reporting year.

Beginning Cash Balance:

Erter the cash balance of Motor Vehicle Highway. Local Road and Street, and Cumulative Bridge fund at January 1 of the reporting year. It is not necessary to enter the cash balances for other Hods. For counties, the cash balances entered in this report should agree with the cash balances in the Auditor's funds ledger. For cities or towns, the cash balances entered in this report should agree with the cash balances on the funds ledger as maintained by the Controller or Clerk-Treasurer (as applicable).

Receipts:

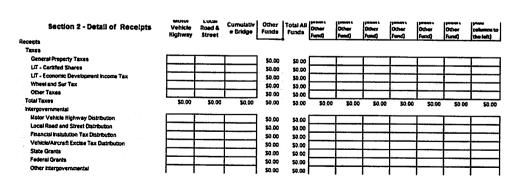
