Subject: Calumet College of St. Joseph - Elementary Education Generalist Program

Representatives from Calumet College of St. Joseph (CCSJ) are seeking final approval to offer a new Elementary Education Generalist program at the undergraduate initial licensure level. Program completers who complete all program requirements and meet all licensure requirements will be eligible for an initial practitioner elementary generalist license.

After reviewing all feedback received from members of the Indiana Educator Preparation Program Review Team (INPREP) and, pursuant to 511 IAC 13-1-1, Sec. 1, (d), the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) recommends that the Indiana State Board of Education approve the following new program:

• Calumet College of St. Joseph: Elementary Education Generalist (K-6)

IDOE will continue to monitor the progress of the above program by reviewing all annual reports required of CCSJ, including candidate performance data submitted to the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation and IDOE.
