SUBJECT:	2013 Summer School Program

The Department of Education is seeking approval of the 2013 summer school program. The three-category method of classifying courses for the purpose of reimbursing instructional costs is detailed below. Courses classified as Category I will be reimbursed at 105 percent—if supported by the appropriation. If not supported by the appropriation, it will be reduced proportionately among all claims submitted to the department. These costs will be deducted from the total summer school appropriation and the remaining funds allocated to reimburse Category 2 and 3 eligible costs.

## Eligible Programs:

## Category | classes

Grades I – 3: Reading Grades 9 – 12: Courses towards graduation, including electives <u>Category 2 classes</u> Grades I – 8: Language Arts and Mathematics Grades 4 – 8: Reading <u>Category 3 classes</u>

Grades 1 – 8: All other curricular programs, enrichment and multidisciplinary classes

Grades 9 - 12: Courses not counting toward graduation
