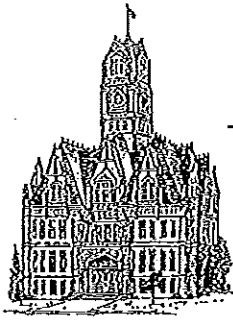

PUBLIC NOTICE

Reorganization Plan for the Kankakee Valley School Corporation Board of School Trustees. The Board of School Trustees of the Kankakee Valley School Corporation is planning to reorganize the configuration of the Board by moving one of the two at-large elected positions to an alternate elections cycle. Under the current plan, two at-large seats are elected every four years, with the next election being held November, 2014. The Reorganization Plan will move one of the at-large seats to a two year term in 2014. This at-large seat will be elected on a four year cycle for the subsequent years.

The Kankakee Valley School Corporation is required to issue a public notice and the School Corporation is obligated to wait 120 days for the public to respond to the proposed reorganization.

The public has 120 days to respond to the proposed change by petitioning the Board of School Trustees by following the directions found in Indiana Code IC 20-23-8-11. Voters may initiate a plan, protest a plan, or introduce an alternate plan.

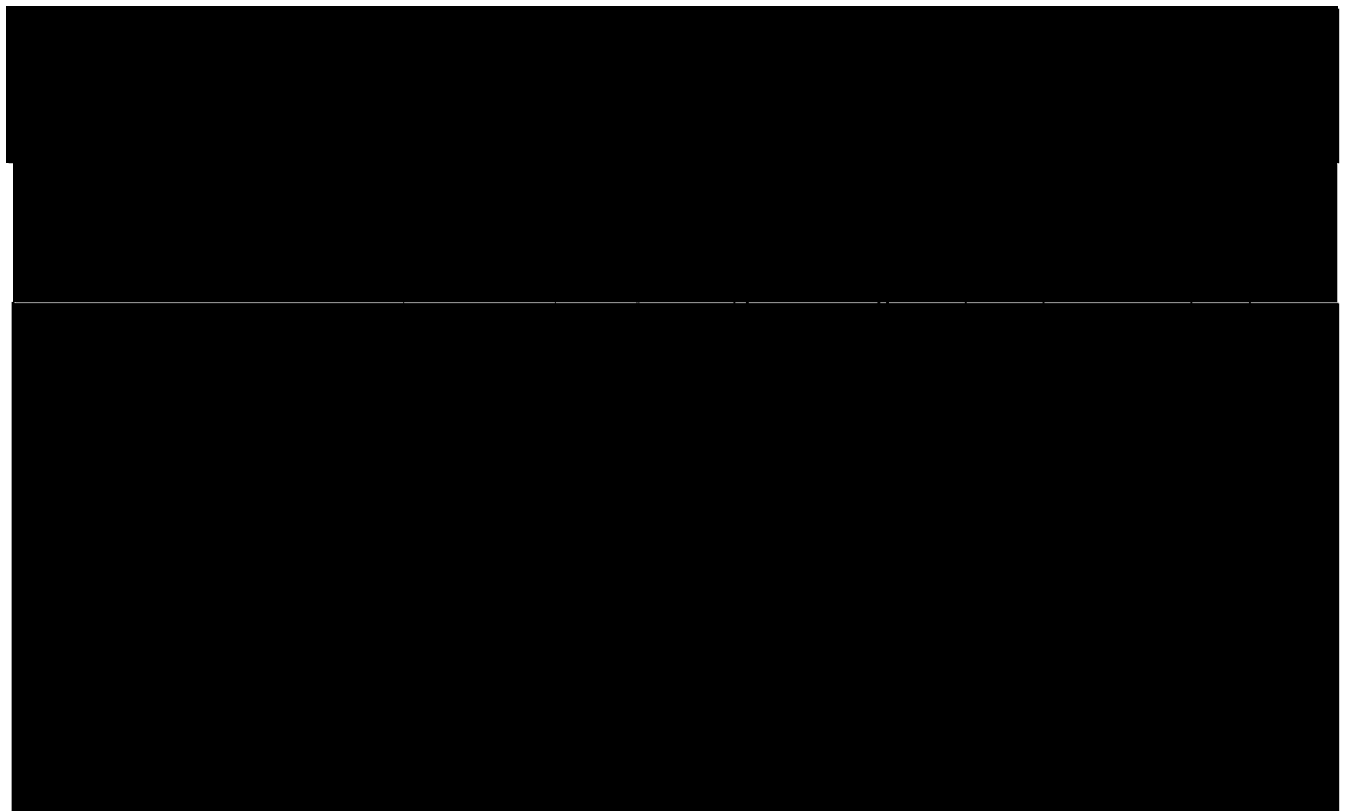


