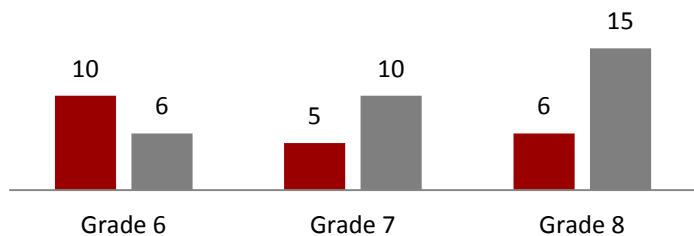

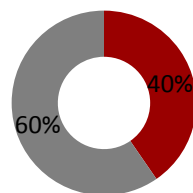

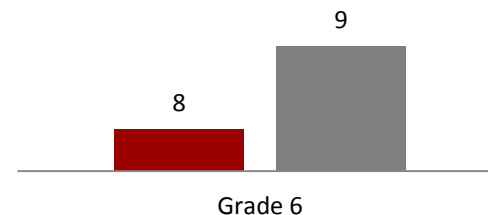

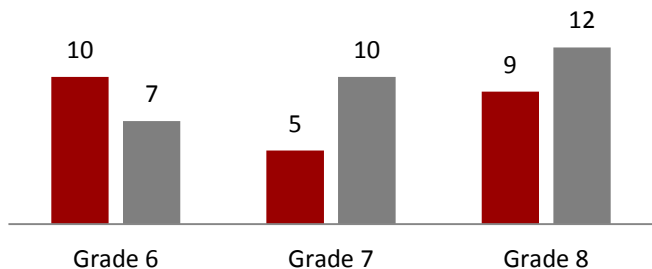
Grade 6 Students

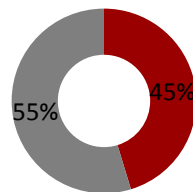
