Subject: 2025-2026 WIDA Assessment Guidance

The Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) annually reviews assessment guidance. Updates to guidance occur due to WIDA updates, changes in state or federal English Learner (EL) programming requirements or guidance, updates to the assessments or accommodations, and additional support needed based on review of the previous assessment administration. Members of the Office of Student Assessment and the Office of English Learners and Migrant Education participate in WIDA subcommittees and collaborate with other state education agencies.
