- (2) Graduation rate (as defined in IC 20-26-13-6) and the graduation rate excluding students that receive a graduation waiver under IC 20-32-4-4. – currently report grad rate; need to add Waiver data for March 2016 posting
- (3) Attendance rate. – currently report
- (4) The following test scores, including the number and percentage of students meeting academic standards: - currently reporting all test data requirements below
 - (A) All state standardized assessment scores.
 - (B) Scores for assessments under IC 20-32-5-21, if appropriate.
 - (C) For a freeway school, scores on a locally adopted assessment program, if appropriate.
- (5) Average class size. – already agreed to suggest removing
- (6) The school's performance category or designation of school improvement assigned under IC 20-31-8.- need to add for March 2016 posting
- (7) The number and percentage of students in the following groups or programs:
 - (A) Alternative education, if offered.- need to add for March 2016 posting
 - (B) Career and technical education. – currently reported
 - (C) Special education. – currently reported
 - (D) High ability. – currently reported
 - (E) Remediation. – already agreed to suggest removing; do not collect this data

- (F) Limited English language proficiency. – **currently reported**
- (G) Students receiving free or reduced price lunch under the national school lunch program. – **currently reported**
- (H) School flex program, if offered. – **agreed to suggest removing; not enough data to report**

(8) Advanced placement, including the following:

(11) The percentage of graduates considered college and career ready in a manner prescribed by the state board. – **need to add for March 2016 posting**

(12) School safety, including:

- (A) the number of students receiving suspension or expulsion for the possession of alcohol, drugs, or weapons; - **currently reported (link for future?)**
- (B) the number of incidents reported under IC 20-33-9; and - **need to add for March 2016 posting; (link for future?)**
- (C) the number of bullying incidents reported under IC 20-34-6 by category. – **need to add for March 2016 posting; (link for future?)**

(13) Financial information and various school cost factors, including the following:

- (A) Expenditures per pupil. **Move to a link-currently reported**
- (B) Average teacher salary. **Move to a link-currently reported**
- (C) Remediation funding. **Move to a link-currently reported**

(14) ~~Interdistrict and intradistrict student mobility rates, if that information is available.~~ – **suggest to have removed (already agreed) – currently reported**

(15) The number and percentage of each of the following within the school corporation:

- (A) Teachers who are certificated employees (as defined in IC 20-29-2-4). – **need to add for March 2015 posting (link for future?)**
- (B) Teachers who teach the subject area for which the teacher is certified and holds a license.- **need to add for March 2016 posting (link for future?)**
- (C) Teachers with national board certification.- **need to add for March 2016 posting (link for future?)**

(16) The percentage of grade 3 students reading at grade 3 level.- **currently reported**

(17) The number of students expelled, ~~including the number participating in other recognized education programs during their expulsion~~, including the percentage of students expelled by race, grade, gender, free or reduced lunch status, and eligibility for special education. – **no way to collect this data – currently report expelled data; need to add for March 2016 posting the disaggregate data**
