RE: Approval of Governing Body Change - Liberty-Perry Community School

Corporation

Recommendation: Approve the proposed governing body plan change

Pursuant to IC 20-23-8, the Board of School Trustees of Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation ("Liberty-Perry") adopted a resolution to initiate a change to Liberty-Perry's governing body plan. After adopting the resolution, Liberty-Perry submitted the attached materials for the Indiana State Board of Education's ("Board") review and consideration, in accordance with the requirements set forth in IC 20-23-8-15.

Indiana Department of Education ("Department") staff reviewed the attached material and determined that Liberty-Perry's plan and the manner in which it was initiated satisfy the requirements set forth in IC 20-23-8. As such, Liberty-Perry's new governing body plan is recommended for approval.

A RESOLUTION INITIATING AN AMENDED AND RESTATED PLAN OF ORGANIZATION CHANGING THE GOVERNING BODY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT COMPOSITION

WHEREAS, Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation was created pursuant to a countywide school reorganization plan that was adopted pursuant to the School Reorganization Act of 1959; approved by the Indiana State Commission on School Reorganization on or about ______; and ratified by the voters of the newly created Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation at a primary election held May 5, 1964; and

WHEREAS, the Board of School Trustees (hereinafter "Board") of Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation was originally constituted as a five-member non-partisan elected board with two (2) members thereof elected from Liberty Township to be voted on by voters residing in Liberty Township, two (2) members thereof elected from Perry Township to be voted on by voters residing in Perry Township, and one (1) At-Large member to be voted on by all voters located in the newly formed school district in the primary election immediately preceding the June 30 end of a member's four-year term; and

WHEREAS, subsequent shifts in population for each Township located within the school district have caused the current Board to conclude that there should be initiated a proposed plan to change the method of electing the Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation Board; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Indiana Code (I.C.) 20-23-8, et. seq., provide the Board with the authority and designated processes by which such a proposed plan to change the composition of the residential districts that comprise a governing body of a public-school corporation might be initiated, advertised and ultimately adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Board that pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 20-23-8-10(a)(2), it hereby adopts the following changes in the Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation Organization Plan by which members of the Board are to be elected following the Effective Date hereof, as set forth below.

(End of Recitals - Here Follows Amended and Restated Plan)

AMENDED AND RESTATED PLAN FOR CHANGE IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT COMPOSITION OF GOVERNING BODY

- A. Board of School Trustees (Board) of the Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation
 - 1. Number & Residential Districts The governance of Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation shall be vested in a non-partisan Board composed of five (5) members elected at a November general election in accordance with the provisions of I.C. 20-23-4-29 and of I.C. 3-8-2.5. There shall be created two (2) geographically defined and limited residential districts.
 - i. <u>District No. 1</u> shall consist of the present geographical boundaries of Liberty Township, Delaware County, Indiana.
 - a. At the general election for Delaware County, Indiana, the registered voters of Liberty Township and Perry Township shall elect two (2) members to the Board of Trustees as District No. 1 representatives who each reside within the geographical boundaries of District No. 1
 - ii. <u>District No. 2</u> shall consist of the present geographical boundaries of Perry Township, Delaware County, Indiana.
 - a. At the general election for Delaware County, Indiana, the registered voters of Liberty Township and Perry Township shall elect two (2) members to the Board of Trustees as District No. 2 representatives who each reside within the geographical boundaries of District No. 2.
 - iii. <u>At Large</u> shall consist of the present geographical boundaries of Liberty Township and Perry Township, both of Delaware County, Indiana.
 - a. At the general election for Delaware County, Indiana, the registered voters of Liberty Township and Perry Township shall elect one (1) member to the Board of Trustees as an At-Large member who resides within the geographical boundaries of Liberty Township and Perry Township.
 - Term of Office Membership on the Liberty-Perry Community School Board shall constitute the holding of a "lucrative office" as said term is used in Article 2, Section 9, of the Constitution of the State of Indiana. Members shall be elected to

be filled in the manner provided by I.C. 20-26-4-4(c), as from time to time amended.

B. Transition Plan Pending Board Elections

1. - 2. <u>Transition of Residential District Representation</u> The representation of the existing residential districts shall be transitioned under this proposed plan change in the following manner:
 - i. In the November, 2022 general election, the term of member Keith Davis (Liberty Township District 1), would end at year end and his replacement would run as the candidate for the residential District 1 (Liberty Township) to be voted on by all eligible voters in the Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation. The elected replacement candidate would commence his/her term of office as of January 1, 2023, and the term would end as of December 31, 2026.
 - ii. In the November, 2022 general election, the term of Robert Paul Cook (Perry Township District 2) would end at year end and his replacement would run as the candidate for the residential District 2 (Perry Township) to be voted on by all eligible voters in the Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation. The elected replacement candidate

would commence his/her term of office as of January 1, 2023, and the term would end as of December 31, 2026.

- iii. In the November, 2022 general election, the term of Kevin Thomas (At Large) would end at year end and his replacement would run as the "at large" candidate to be voted on by all eligible voters in the Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation. The elected replacement candidate would commence his/her term of office as of January 1, 2023, and the term would end as of December 31, 2026.
- iv. In the November, 2024 general election, the term of Kevin Nemyer (Liberty Township District 1), would end at year end and his replacement would run as the candidate for the residential District 1 (Liberty Township) to be voted on by all eligible voters in the Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation. The elected replacement candidate would commence his/her term of office as of January 1, 2025, and the term would end as of December 31, 2028.
- v. In the November, 2024 general election, the term of Austin R. Rich (Perry Township District 2), would end at year end and his replacement would run as the candidate for the residential District 2 (Perry Township) to be voted on by all eligible voters in the Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation. The elected replacement candidate would commence his/her term of office as of January 1, 2025, and the term would end as of December 31, 2028.
- 3. Election Date for Board Members under Proposed Plan Change Upon passage of this proposed plan change and it becoming effective upon the Effective Date, all members of the Board will be elected at general elections held in November of the appropriate years as set forth above (assuming this proposed Plan Amendment is approved in time for the declaration of candidacies for the 2022 November general election).
- Retention of Terms of Originally Adopted Plan of Organization Except as specifically modified herein all other terms and conditions of the original Liberty-

Perry Community School Corporation Plan of Reorganization, as adopted on or about July 1, 1964 shall remain fully effective after the Effective Date hereof.

C. Effective Date

1. All aspects of this proposed plan change shall become effective as of its certification by the Indiana Department of Education or on July 1, 2022, whichever is the earlier (assuming no protest petitions to this Board initiated plan or alternate plans are filed).

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that not later than one hundred twenty (120) days after the publication of this notice voters residing within the overall boundaries of the Liberty-Perry Community School Corporation may file with the clerk of the Delaware Circuit Court a petition protesting the above Plan or a petition submitting an alternative plan in accordance with the following parameters:

- (1) A petition protesting the above Plan shall be signed by at least twenty percent (20%) of the voters of the school corporation or five hundred (500) voters of the school corporation, whichever is less.
- (2) A petition submitting an alternative plan shall be signed by at least twenty percent (20%) of the voters of the school corporation.
