

# Indiana High School Accountability Framework

## 1. Academic Proficiency

Measures whether students have met the "college- and career-ready" proficiency benchmark on Indiana's statewide high school assessment.<sup>1</sup>

## 2. High School Graduation

Measures whether students have completed all Indiana high school graduation requirements, including a high school diploma and Graduation Pathways.

## 3. College & Career Readiness

Measures whether students have satisfied the requirements of at least one of the postsecondary outcomes (Enrollment, Employment, Enlistment) listed below.

### ENROLLMENT

Percent of Students Who:

- Earn a General Education Certificate (STGEC)<sup>2</sup> by high school graduation; **OR**
- Earn a short- or long-term workforce certificate<sup>3</sup> by high school graduation; **OR**
- **Enroll in postsecondary education without remediation upon high school graduation**

### EMPLOYMENT

Percent of Students Who:

- Earn an Industry-Recognized Certification<sup>4</sup> by high school graduation; **OR**
- Earn a short- or long-term workforce certificate by high school graduation; **OR**
- **Be employed through an apprenticeship (or comparable on-the-job training program)<sup>5</sup> upon high school graduation**

### ENLISTMENT

Percent of Students Who:

- **Enlist and serve in military with qualifying ASVAB score upon high school graduation**

**BOLD TYPE** to be reported in the graduation report due annually in the fall immediately following high school graduation year.

<sup>1</sup> Measures students' first attempt on state assessment for accountability purposes

<sup>2</sup> Statewide Transfer General Education Core (includes qualifying AP, IB and Dual Credits)

<sup>3</sup> At least 15 career-technical education credits in a single certificate path, resulting in a postsecondary credential

<sup>4</sup> List of qualifying industry certifications approved by the Governor's Workforce Cabinet

<sup>5</sup> Program must be recognized by the state and culminate in a postsecondary credential

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Honors Diploma:</b> Fulfill all requirements of either the Academic or Technical Honors diploma; OR</li> <li>• <b>ACT:</b> College-ready benchmarks; OR</li> <li>• <b>SAT:</b> College-ready benchmarks; OR</li> <li>• <b>ASVAB:</b> Earn at least a minimum AFQT score to qualify for placement into one of the branches of the US military; OR</li> <li>• <b>State- and Industry-recognized Credential or Certification;</b> OR</li> <li>• <b>Federally-recognized Apprenticeship;</b> OR</li> <li>• <b>Career-Technical Education Concentrator:</b> Must earn a C average in at least two non-duplicative advanced courses (courses beyond an introductory course) within a particular program or program of study; OR</li> <li>• <b>AP/IB/Dual Credit/Cambridge International courses or CLEP Exams:</b> Must earn a C average or higher in at least three courses; OR</li> </ul>	<p><b>College Ready (aka ENROLLMENT)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Certificate:</b> Student earns a General Education Certificate (AP, IB, Cambridge International and/or Dual Credits) or a long- or short-term workforce certificate.</li> </ul> <p><b>Career Ready (aka EMPLOYMENT)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Apprenticeship:</b> Student is employed through an apprenticeship or equivalent on-the-job training program that culminates in a postsecondary credential; <b>OR</b></li> <li>• <b>Certificate:</b> Student earns a long- or short-term workforce certificate; <b>OR</b></li> <li>• <b>Certification:</b> Student earns a high-value state-approved Industry-Recognized Certification.</li> </ul> <p><b>Military Ready (aka ENLISTMENT)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>ASVAB:</b> Student enlists and serves in military with a minimum AFQT score to qualify for placement into one of the branches of the US military.</li> </ul>
