


Recommendations Instead of Due Process

ICOSA Recommendations for Early Dispute Resolution

- 1. <u>Funding for Advocacy Groups:</u> In general, the ICOSA Special Education Sub-Committee recommends further study on methods of funding for advocacy groups to encourage parental participation in the interactive process. Specifically, it is important to encourage additional parent-school interaction during Case Conferences.
- 2. <u>Hearing Officers as Mediators:</u> We believe there is value in Hearing Officers also serving as Mediators to build their knowledge of common hearing issues and to facilitate prehearing resolution of such issues.
- 3. <u>Hearing Officer Training:</u> We support training being provided with collaboration between parent and school attorneys on substantive materials and presentations on regulation, case law, and trends. Such collaboration could include a combined parent and school attorney group half-day input session.
- 4. <u>Board of Special Education Appeals:</u> We encourage study/cost-benefit analysis on potentially reinstating the BSEA.
