**RE:** Rule Readoptions

---

**OVERVIEW:** Administrative rules adopted under IC 4-22-2.5 expire January 1 of the seventh year after the year in which the rule took effect. These rules may be readopted or allowed to expire. The Legislative Services Agency (“LSA”) provided Board staff with a list of rules set to expire on January 1, 2019. On July 11, 2018, the Indiana State Board of Education (“Board”) approved filing a Notice of Intent to Readopt the rules set to expire, which Board staff submitted to LSA for publication. This action triggered a 30 day waiting period in which a request can be made in writing for any part of the re adoption to be separate from this action. To date there have been no written requests. Therefore, Board staff recommends the Board readopt the following rules:

- 511 IAC 7-48 Minimum Expenditure Requirements
- 511 IAC 10-6 Staff Performance Evaluation
