MEMORANDUM

Recommendation: Amend 511 IAC 6 to account for recent updates and other policy changes.

The State Board of Education (“Board”) staff recommends the Board amend 511 IAC 6 (Driver Education; Graduation Requirements; Nonstandard Programs; High Ability Students; Postsecondary Enrollment), as amendments are needed to account for recent updates and other policy changes.

The Board will not be approving any language at this meeting. The Board is merely granting Board staff permission to initiate the rulemaking process. The process will proceed as follows:

- Staff will file initial paperwork with LSA to let them know we have approval from the Board to initiate the rulemaking process.
- Staff will present a Proposed Rule to the Board for adoption at a later meeting.
- Once adopted by the Board, the Proposed Rule will be published for public comment, and a public hearing will be held.
- The Board will adopt a Final Rule based on public comments received at the hearing and any recommended technical changes from staff.
