School Accountability Panel – Postsecondary Outcome Ideas

1. Postsecondary Readiness (as defined in CHE’s College Readiness Report)
 - % of students remediation free
 - % of students who complete attempted coursework
 - % of students who persist to 2nd year
2. % of students who leave high school with college credit
3. % of students who leave high school with an industry certification or as a CTE concentrator
4. High school graduation rates
5. College & Career Readiness Indicator – include all postsecondary readiness competencies listed in Grad Pathways
6. % of students who graduate with Statewide Transfer General Education Core (30 hours)
7. % of students who graduate with high-wage, high-demand credentials
8. Postsecondary completions – bachelor’s degrees and others
9. Job placement and wages out of high school
10. Enrollment in any postsecondary academic institution
11. Employment in any of the following:
 - A job recognized as gainful employment as classified by DWD
 - A job or program that provides future opportunity
 - A certification program that is listed for a specific skill or trade
 - A job outside of the State of Indiana that can be verified
12. Enlistment in any branch of the armed services
13. “Other Life Circumstances” – any student that is not enrolled, employed, or enlisted – should not count for or against any school corporation

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- 15.** % of students that have completed or will be engaged in any of the following activities upon graduation from high school:
- Enrollment in a postsecondary institution
 - Enrollment in a training, apprenticeship, internship, or certification program
 - Enlistment in the military
 - Enlistment in a volunteer service
 - Full-time employment
- 16.** % of students that demonstrate competency in the following areas upon graduation from high school:
- Employability skills
 - Teamwork
 - Critical thinking
 - Problem solving
- 17.** % of CTE concentrators graduating from high school having attained a recognized credential
- 18.** Postsecondary Proficiency – student meets/exceeds the “college and career ready” proficiency benchmark on state’s accountability assessment
- 19.** Postsecondary Credentials – postsecondary certificates or industry-recognized credentials
- 20.** Postsecondary Progress – postsecondary enrollment or enlistment
- 21.** Postsecondary Credentials – certificates/credentials recognized by GWC
- 22.** Amount of collaboration with industry and nonprofits as proven by the number of work-based learning opportunities completed by students – internships/apprenticeships
- 23.** Number of dual credit, Cambridge, AP, IB courses offered AND separately as a % completed
- 24.** Number of CTE concentrators offered AND separately as a % completed
- 25.** % of students enrolled/enlisted/employed
- 26.** % of graduates that require remediation or % of graduates that are remediation free
