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PURPOSE AND AUDIENCE FOR THIS DOCUMENT

Purpose

This document details data and functional requirements, for the APR Changes for 2016 in Compass. These requirements will provide business rules and formats for the reporting functions, residing in Learning Connection.

Audience

This document is targeted to application developers, database developers and data analysts. These requirements provide the guidelines for the design, development and testing of the APR Changes for 2016.

INTRODUCTION

Indiana Department of Education is required to make educational performance statistical data available to the public. The IDOE supports a public website which will be used to distribute this information. This data will be presented in graphical reports in a dashboard interface, or a 'snapshot'. Each school corporation, school, in the State of Indiana will be represented with one standard snapshot

BUSINESS CASE

AVAILABILITY

These reports will be available for view according to the availability schedule of the IDOE public website.

This is not an ad-hoc report. This is not a customizable report. Although the report will allows users to drill down to detail levels all data in a report is static and reflects snapshots of the most current years' statistics.

SCHEDULING

The report should be updated on a yearly scheduled basis to display preliminary spring results and final summer results. There are multiple data sources referenced within the snapshot interface. This will result in multiple yearly updates to the report in order to update all contained report objects.
