Data Collection Instruments for Evaluating Family Involvement



Three Recommendations:

- 1. <u>Page 6 Parent and School Survey (PASS)</u> * *FREE* – (*Download online*)
- 2. <u>Page 10 Parent–Teacher Involvement Questionnaire:</u> Parent (PTIQ-P)
 - * **FREE** (can be downloaded online. Download the information, but omit their personalized information on the survey.)
- Page 11 School and Family Partnership: Surveys and Summaries 10
 * \$20 to order one set of surveys



Updates continued...

- 1. What is the timeframe for implementation of the instruments? Immediately, once surveys are downloaded or purchased.
- 2. How long would it take to implement each instrument? Each instrument is between 21-26 items.
- 3. What are the barriers to implementation of the instruments? Logistics on how the surveys will be distributed and who will distribute them.





- * Tier II and Tier III Schools (23).
- * Schools that have been identified by Outreach Coordinators as being in a need of additional FACE support.
- * The **Pilot** is being suggested as a means to work out the logistics and process of administering the survey most efficiently, as to gathering concrete data.



Next steps for parent survey process:

- * Follow-up with University professors.
- * Follow-up with recommendation from Great Lakes on the state of Ohio's state-wide parent survey process.
- * Qualify results of Pilot not a sample of the entire state.
- * Recommendations from the SBOE Strategic Planning Committee.
