Recommended Updates to the State Board of Education Strategic Plan

The goal of 1.1.9: *Encourage districts to increase the number of students in middle and high school participating in higher-level courses* is to encourage more **participation** of higher-level courses and not necessarily look at the scores of those students.

Given this information, the leading indicator “% of students tested that score level 3 on AP exams/level 4 on IB exams” from 1.1.9 has been removed and placed as a new goal, 1.1.10.

With this modification, the goal of 1.1.9 is to encourage more **participation** of higher-level courses and 1.1.10 is focuses on **student outcomes** on the college and career ready courses or assessments.

Additionally, 1.1.11 has been added to align to the Governor’s goal of having 100,000 more students enrolled in A or B schools by 2020. As shared by the Governor, there are currently 100,000 students enrolled in D and F schools. As the State Board of Education (SBOE) continuous to monitor overall school improvement efforts and oversees school accountability, it makes sense to specifically monitor progress toward this goal in the SBOE’s Strategic Plan.
