Given the information above, SBOE Staff recommends removing the leading indicator "% of students tested that score level 3 on AP exams/level 4 on IB exams" from 1.1.9 since we include it here in 1.1.10.

The goal of 1.1.9 is to encourage more participation of higher-level courses and not necessarily look at the scores of those students participating. Now some correlation between participation and scores would be good to look at because we don't want students taking courses that they are unprepared for, but the scores indicating college/career readiness aren't necessarily indicative of increased participation as stated in goal 1.1.9.
