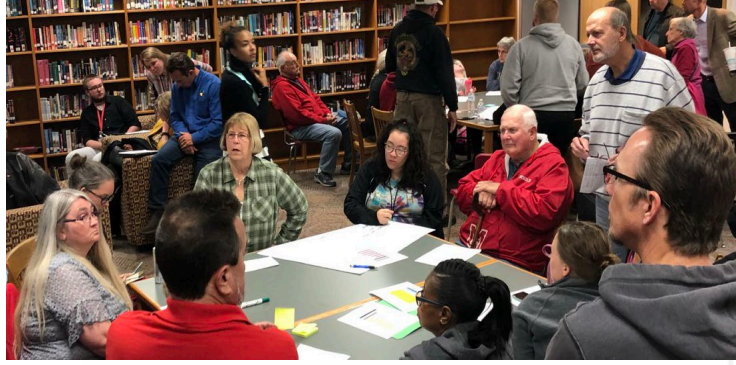


SCHOOL TRANSITION TASK FORCE

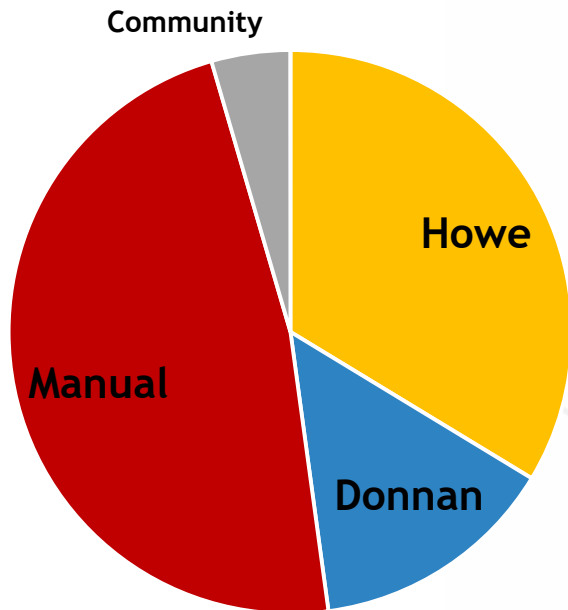


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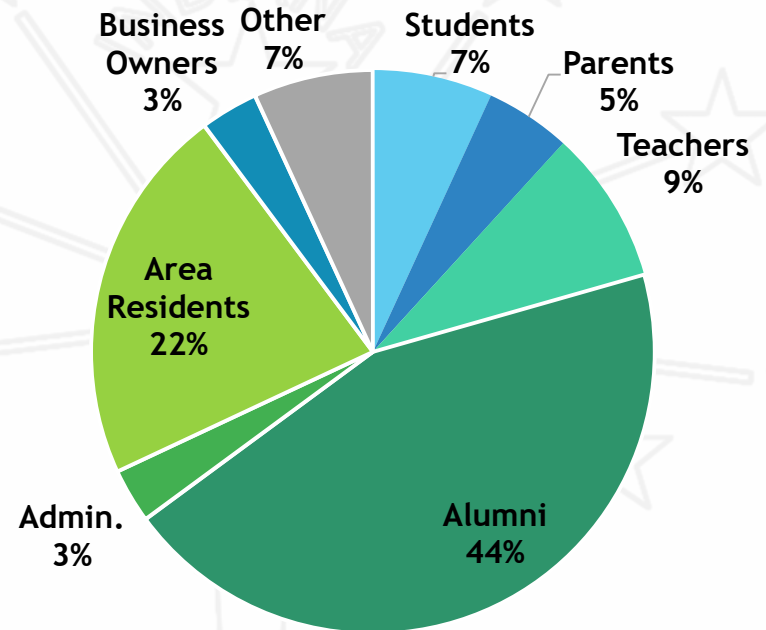

Avenues for Community Input and Participation:

- Five community meetings in schools and in neighborhood gathering spots around them.
- Stakeholder surveys, completed at community meetings (205) or via internet (238).
- Monthly newsletters and weekly social media posts, reaching 5,000+ stakeholders.



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KEY FINDINGS

1. *Donnan is different.*

IPS and CSUSA is discussing plans to renew their 2015 innovation agreement and turn Emma Donnan into a K-8.



2. *IPS sticks to its plan.*

In October, the IPS Board confirmed: it will not operate Howe or Manual as high schools if returned to them.



3. *Chartering is an option.*

If SBOE directs it to do so, the Special Management Team intends to seek charters for each school.



THE CHARTER OPTION

If directed to seek charters, CSUSA will need to...

- Team up with a nonprofit “organizer” to apply to one of the state’s charter authorizers.*
- Demonstrate financial sustainability through the authorizing process.*
- Lease or buy its facility.*
