SUBJECT: APC funding for Special Education

Indiana Code 20-43-4-4 provides that the State Board of Education shall monitor changes that occur after the fall ADM count in the number of students enrolled in programs for children with disabilities and shall make an adjusted count before December 2. The State Superintendent shall certify the December adjusted count to the State Budget Committee before February 5.

Please find attached the December I, 2011, special education additional pupil counts (APCs) for your acceptance as required by IC 20-43-4-4. Also provided is a three year comparison of special education counts by Group I, II, and III as well as the December I pre-school count.
