RE: Amend 511 IAC 6.2 School Performance and Growth; Accountability

MEMORANDUM

Recommendation: amend 511 IAC 6.2 to account for anticipated changes in academic accountability necessitated by the introduction of the Every Student Succeeds Act (“ESSA”).

The State Board of Education (“Board”) staff recommend the Board amend 511 IAC 6.2 (School Performance and Growth; Accountability administrative rules) as the existing administrative rules have not been updated to account for anticipated changes in academic accountability necessitated by the introduction of ESSA. The Board will not be approving any language at this meeting, merely granting the Board staff permission to begin the rulemaking process. The process will proceed as follows:

- Staff will file initial paperwork with LSA to let them know we have approval from the Board to begin the rulemaking process.
- Staff will present a Proposed Rule to the Board for adoption at a later meeting.
- Once a Proposed Rule is adopted by the Board, it will be published for public comment, and a public hearing will be held.
- The Board will then adopt a Final Rule based on public comments and any recommended technical changes from staff.
