
7th and 8th Grade Acuity Results On Track to Pass Both ELA and Math ISTEP+

PASSING	75% increase from 22% to 38% of students passing both ELA and Math
PARTICIPATION	11% increase from 89.5% to 99% of students participating (274 tested)
Within 1 Item of Passing	15 students (5%) would have passed had one more item been correct
High GROWTH	A bell-shaped performance curve has replaced a skewed-left performance curve



7th and 8th Grade Acuity Results ELA: Growth


ELA Growth Data All Students





7th and 8th Grade Acuity Results Math: Growth


Math Growth Data ALL Students

- Quality Review student interviews




