

FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

You are notified the Administrative Law Judge, acting on behalf of the State Employees' Appeals Commission, now enters a final order of dismissal as to the Complaint of Petitioner Sellers. On April 18, 2016, the ALJ issued his Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Non-Final Order ("Order"), ruling that Respondent Indiana Family and Social Services Administration had just cause to terminate Petitioner. The Order is incorporated by reference herein. In the Order, the ALJ gave Petitioner until May 10, 2016, to object to the order with supporting documentation. No objection was received. Therefore, the ALJ's April 18, 2016 Order is now final.

The Complaint, and this action, is hereby **DISMISSED** with prejudice. This is the Final Order of the Commission in this matter. A person who wishes to seek judicial review must file a petition in an appropriate court within thirty (30) days of this order and must otherwise comply with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-5.
