Approval of Minutes:

• Minutes from October and November approved by unanimous consent. As there was not a quorum in November, November's notes are advisory.

Update from the Secretary's Office

- Holli Sullivan was appointed as the Secretary of State. The transition was smooth. Holli was unable to attend today's meeting, but she looks forward to working with the commission.
- Executive Order 20-23 regarding reinstatements has been rescinded.
- Executive Order 20-23 regarding remote business meetings is still in effect.
- Corporate Transparency Act update was passed January 1, 2021
 - FinCEN has one year to write the rules. The expectation is that the legislation/rules will be in effect on January 20, 2022. FinCEN is receiving a lot of pressure to meet the deadline.
 - Secretaries of State are required to notify businesses of this filing requirement.
 - FinCEN was published the ANPRN on 4/5. Deadlines for answers to ANPRN is 5/5.
 - NASS is coordinating information to Secretaries of State and requesting that filing offices respond to the ANPRN.

Legislative Update

 HB 1464 was amended in the Senate, returned to the House for concurrence, The vote was 86-0 to concur. The office is awaiting a signature from the Governor. The bill will be effective on passage.

Old Business:

- Official Comments to the Indiana Business Flexibility Act
 - Commissioner Sullivan will review a working draft and distribution to the working group on May 15th.
 - Chairman Becker requested anyone interested in working on the project to contact him.

New Business:

• 2021 & 2022 Calendar Year Proposals

- Secretary's office has a list of technical issues in Title 23.
- Commissioner Sullivan recommends updating Indiana statute in relation to the Uniform Partnership Act and Uniform Limited Partnership Act during the 2023 legislative session.
- Chairman Becker requested an update on the former RMBCA to IBCL Comparison project. Stu Gutwein is going to see if he still has the working notes.

Return to in person meetings

Chairman Becker asked commissioners whether they were ready to begin in person meetings. Some commissioners were comfortable with returning to in person meetings and others stated a preference to continue remote attendance. Chairman Becker is hopeful to have an in person meeting by June with an option for remote attendance.

Recommendations to fill vacancies

- Becca is still collecting recommendations on behalf of the Secretary.
- Becca will follow up with the executive office to determine timing for filling vacancies.
