Update from the Secretary's Office

- Corporate Transparency Act update
 - First comment period has closed. The proposed rules will be published in July followed by a second period of public comment.
 - The proposed rules are expected to contain a provision barring the use of bearer shares not currently included under Indiana law.
- Federal Remote Notary Legislation
 - The bill previously failed but is expected to resurface during the legislative year.

Old Business:

 - Chairman Becker will be reaching out to the working group to discuss next steps.

New Business:

- **2021 & 2022 Calendar Year Proposal**
 - Chairman Becker will be sending out a brief poll/survey to assess the priority of items for the coming legislative year.
