## **JULY 1, 2024 LEGISLATIVE AMENDMENTS**

Effective July 1, 2024, changes for dealers include:

- First-time independent car dealers will be required to complete an online training course through the Indiana Independent Auto Dealers Association. This will not apply to existing used car dealers.
- Dealers selling REBUILT or SALVAGE-branded vehicles must use a form prescribed by the Division when making that disclosure to the purchaser. The required form can be downloaded at <a href="https://www.in.gov/sos/dealer/forms/">https://www.in.gov/sos/dealer/forms/</a>.
- Franchise dealers under a stop-sale directive for a new motor vehicle shall be reimbursed by the manufacturer in the amount of 1% of the new vehicle price invoiced to the dealer per month.

Effective July 1, 2025, a fee, product or service performed after the sale, that is not included in the advertised price of the vehicle, must be broken out onto its own line item in the contract for sale or lease.
