## Member Open Discussion

- E-Titling will roll out with BMV in 2025.
  - Odometer statement is still required to be a physical copy by federal law.
- ADSD is working with OAG, DFI, and BMV to work on joint issues that dealers are experiencing.
- Brokering seems to be becoming a large issue in Indiana, especially advertising on social media.
  - o ADSD is informing dealers they have to employ people like that rather than using them as a broker.
  - o This can also result in title jumping.
- ADSD is working with BMV to identify those who are selling more than 11 vehicles in a 12 month period.
- ADSD is working with existing automotive salvage recyclers about the new catalytic convertor law.
  - o Looking into taking action against those who are violating the new laws.
  - Law enforcement is struggling with the affidavit requirement because they do not feel comfortable signing off on the affidavit if they did not see it be removed from the vehicle.
