4 CHAIR MORALES: Good afternoon,  
5 everyone. This meeting of the Indiana State  
6 Recount Commission is called to order. Since all  
7 three members of the Recount Commission are here,  
8 there is quorum for this meeting. My name is  
9 Diego Morales, as Indiana Secretary of State I  
10 serve as chair and a member of the Commission.

11 I am joined by Commissioner Mark Wynn and  
12 Commissioner Michael Claytor. The Indiana  
13 Election Commission of the Secretary of State's  
14 Office provides administrative support to the  
15 Recount Commission. Mr. Brad King serves as the  
16 majority party counsel to the Commission and  
17 Mr. Matthew Kochevar serves as the minority  
18 counsel.

19 our court reporter today is Heather  
20 Orbaugh from as Alliance Court Reporting.  
21 Welcome, Heather. Before we begin, I want to  
22 remind everyone on behalf of the court reporter  
23 to identify yourself when beginning to speak,  
24 spell your name when identifying yourself, speak  
25 clearly, and do not speak at the same time others

1 are speaking.

2 I will now ask Mr. Kochevar to administer  
3 the oath to any candidate in the recount,  
4 attorneys representing candidates in the recount,  
5 and persons involved in the recount. Please  
6 stand for the administration of the oath.

7 MR. KOCHEVAR: All those who will  
8 testify before the Indiana Recount Commission,  
9 please rise, raise your right hand, and say I do  
10 after recitation of the oath.

11 Do you solemnly swear under the penalties  
12 of perjury that the testimony you are about to  
13 give to the Indiana Recount Commission is the  
14 truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the  
15 truth? Please say I do.

16 (All responded I do.)

17 CHAIR MORALES: Thank you,  
18 Matthew. The business of today's meeting agenda  
19 is to act on the Petition for Recount for the  
20 Republican Party Nomination for the Indiana House  
21 District 40. The agenda for today's meeting is  
22 limited to that business. The candidates in the  
23 recount or attorneys representing candidates will  
24 be allowed up to five minutes to address the  
25 Commission. Comments and arguments from the

1 public are not included on today's meeting's  
2 agenda.

3 I will now recognize Mr. Brad King to  
4 review contents of the Commissioners' binders  
5 regarding the recount petition.

6 MR. KING: Thank you,  
7 Mr. Chairman, Members of the Commission. Brad  
8 King, B-r-a-d K-i-n-g. At the May 22, 2024,  
9 Commission meeting I reported that a verified  
10 petition for a recount in this election in ten  
11 identified precincts within House District 40 was  
12 filed with the Election Division by candidate  
13 Brian Posh on May 15, 2024, which was prior to  
14 the filing deadline.

15 As the minutes for that meeting reflect,  
16 I note that on its face the recount petition in  
17 this matter appeared to include each of the  
18 elements required by State statute; however, the  
19 Commission noted that under Indiana Code  
20 3-12-11-12(B), the Commission may only order a  
21 recount in a case where not all precincts were  
22 included in the recount petition when the period  
23 for filing a cross petition in that election  
24 district has passed.

25 That deadline, noon, Tuesday, May 28,

1 2024, has now passed without the filing of any  
2 cross petition in this matter, and as a result I  
3 am not aware of any statutory requirement which  
4 precludes the Commission from acting on this  
5 petition at today's meeting, and I would defer to  
6 my colleague, Mr. Kochevar, for any additional  
7 comments he may have.

8 MR. KOCHAVAR: Mr. Secretary,  
9 Members of the Commission, good afternoon. Of  
10 course I concur with everything that Mr. King has  
11 stated so far and have nothing further to add on  
12 this point.

13 CHAIR MORALES: Thank you,  
14 Matthew. Would the candidate filing the Recount  
15 Petition or their attorneys like to address the  
16 Commission? I don't see anyone. Would the  
17 candidate being challenged or their attorneys  
18 like to address the Commission? I don't see  
19 anyone.

20 For purposes of discussion, is there a  
21 motion to accept the Recount Petition and Order  
22 for Recount Proceeding in this matter?

23 MR. CLAYTOR: So moved.

24 CHAIR MORALES: Is there a second?

25 MR. WYNN: Second.

1 CHAIR MORALES: Is there further  
2 discussion? If there is no further discussion,  
3 we will vote. Those in favor of the motion say  
4 aye.

5 (All responded aye.)

6 CHAIR MORALES: Aye. And those  
7 opposing, nay.

8 (No response.)

9 CHAIR MORALES: The ayes have it,  
10 the Petition is accepted and the recount  
11 proceeding is ordered. We will now move to a  
12 report from the Recount Director. I will now  
13 recognize Mr. Philip Sicuso to provide an update  
14 regarding recount activities since we met on May  
15 22nd. Philip?

16 MR. SICUSO: Thank you, Mr. Chair.  
17 A couple things have happened since our last  
18 meeting. In connection with the Order and  
19 Directive of the Commission, the State Board of  
20 Accounts staff has been to Elkhart County and to  
21 Hendricks County to follow through on  
22 supplementing the -- the supplement to the Order  
23 that was issued by me with respect to the  
24 impoundment materials and to further sort through  
25 some of the materials that were under impoundment



1 so that the staff of each county could proceed  
2 with certifying their results.

3 We have also in House District 49 spent  
4 two days on site in Elkhart County doing preview  
5 counts and for House District 49 as well as some  
6 sorting and advance work by the State Board of  
7 Accounts. That went quite well and we feel like  
8 materials are in order and prepared for the  
9 recount activities to begin next Monday. I  
10 issued an Order earlier this week with respect to  
11 that so that we can get under way Monday morning  
12 at 8:00 am in Elkhart County. So we expect that  
13 to be done in a period of two or three days, at  
14 which point we will have some more information to  
15 bring back to you for further discussion.

16 So we will prepare those materials with  
17 the State Board of Accounts and then once that's  
18 complete, move forward based on your order today  
19 for House District 40 quickly thereafter.

20 CHAIR MORALES: Do the  
21 Commissioners have any questions for the recount  
22 director?

23 MR. WYNN: I do not.

24 MR. CLAYTOR: No.

25 CHAIR MORALES: Thank you, Phil.

1 Now an update from the Indiana State Police. I  
2 would recognize Sergeant Jeff Coffey to provide  
3 an update regarding recount activities since we  
4 met on May 22nd.

5 SERGEANT COFFEY: Thank you,  
6 Mr. Secretary. Jeffrey Coffey, J-e-f-f-r-e-y,  
7 Coffey, C-o-f-f-e-y, Indiana State Police Special  
8 Investigations Section. The Indiana State Police  
9 has followed through with the impoundment orders  
10 and has maintained the security and integrity of  
11 the impoundment items. As of today, they were  
12 checked at the Hendricks County location this  
13 morning and when they access that information,  
14 the State Police will provide security while the  
15 Commission members are reviewing that  
16 information.

17 CHAIR MORALES: Do the  
18 Commissioners have any questions for Sergeant  
19 Coffey?

20 MR. CLAYTOR: No.

21 MR. WYNN: No.

22 CHAIR MORALES: Thank you,  
23 Sergeant.

24 SERGEANT COFFEY: Thank you.

25 CHAIR MORALES: Now an update from

1 the Indiana State Board of Accounts. I will  
2 recognize State Board of Accounts Mr. Paul Joyce  
3 to provide an update regarding recount activities  
4 since May 22nd.

5 MR. JOYCE: Thank you very much.  
6 Paul Joyce, State Examiner, P-a-u-l J-o-y-c-e. I  
7 will second what Phil said about the sorting  
8 activities that took place in Elkhart County and  
9 sorting activities that took place in Hendricks  
10 County. We are willing and ready and ready to  
11 start the recount Monday morning, and will be  
12 ready to start the recount in Hendricks County  
13 upon Order and at the completion of the recount  
14 going on in Elkhart County.

15 CHAIR MORALES: Do the  
16 Commissioners have any questions for Mr. Joyce?

17 MR. WYNN: No.

18 MR. CLAYTOR: No.

19 CHAIR MORALES: Thank you, Paul.

20 MR. JOYCE: Thank you.

21 CHAIR MORALES: Do the  
22 Commissioners or the Recount Director have any  
23 further business for the Commission to consider  
24 or discuss today?

25 MR. SICUSO: No.

1 CHAIR MORALES: If not, there is  
2 motion that the Commission now adjourn. Do I  
3 have a second?

4 MR. WYNN: Second.

5 CHAIR MORALES: Those in favor say  
6 aye and those opposed say nay.

7 (All responded aye.)

8 CHAIR MORALES: The ayes have it,  
9 this meeting is adjourned.
