## **Governor Mike Braun delivers over \$70** million in savings, achieves 3:1 ROI in first six months

Just six months into Governor Mike Braun's first term, the Indiana Department of Administration (IDOA) has delivered more than \$72.2 million in cost avoidance, equivalent to 339% of the department's operating budget, and \$37.6 million in direct savings, representing 177% of the budget. These early results reflect a 3:1 return on investment and highlight the administration's fast-track approach to disciplined, resultsdriven governance.

## Time is running out — earn your 2025 **Wellness Rewards**
