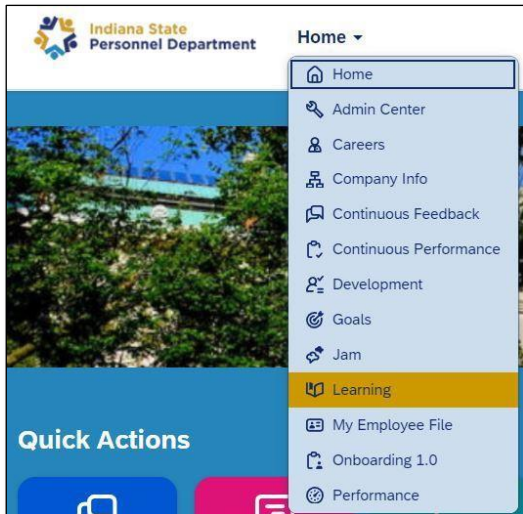




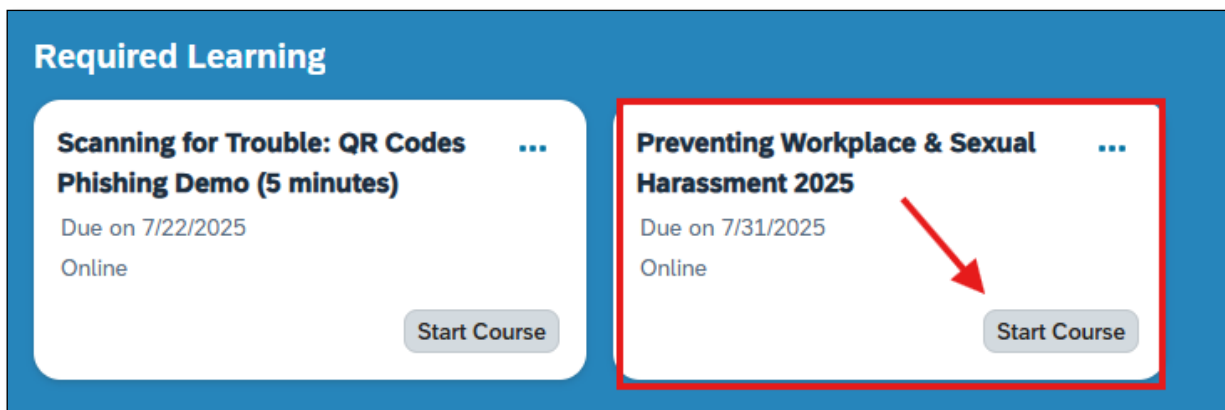

2. Under your “Required Learning” select the Preventing Workplace & Sexual Harassment 2025 **START COURSE** button.

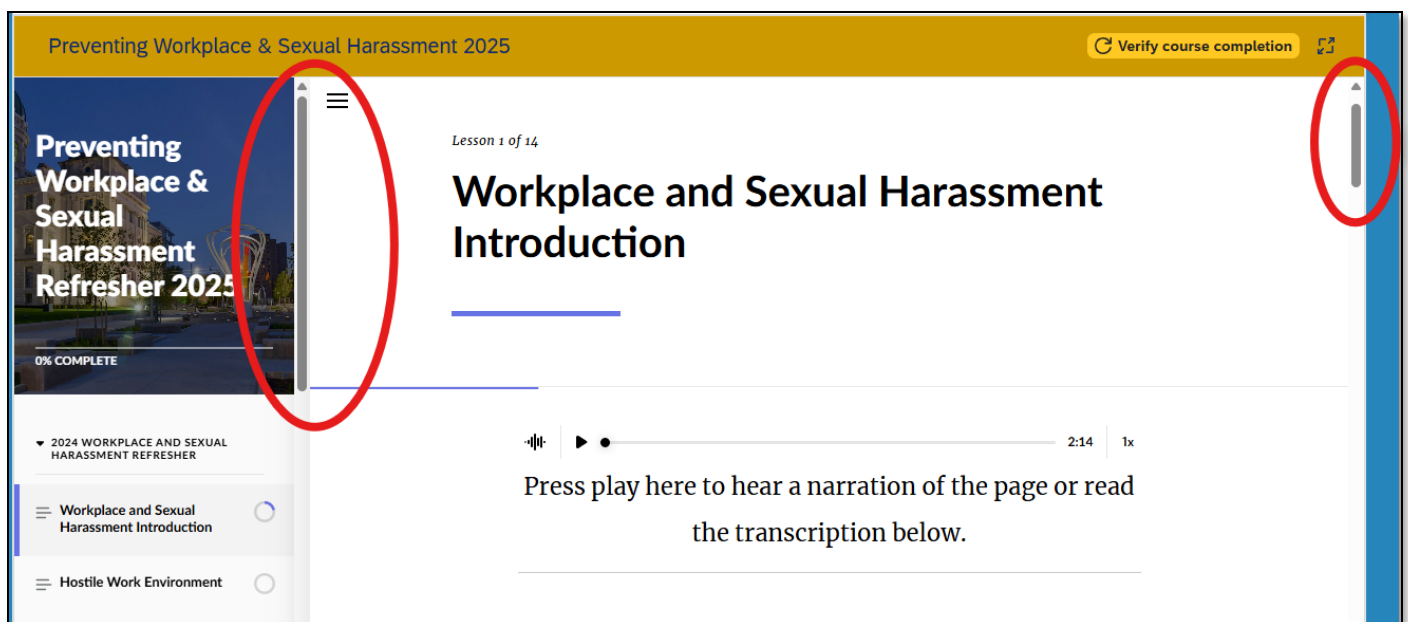




3. Select Start course below the title:



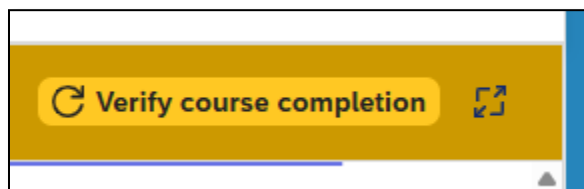
4. The course will load and you will scroll through to proceed.



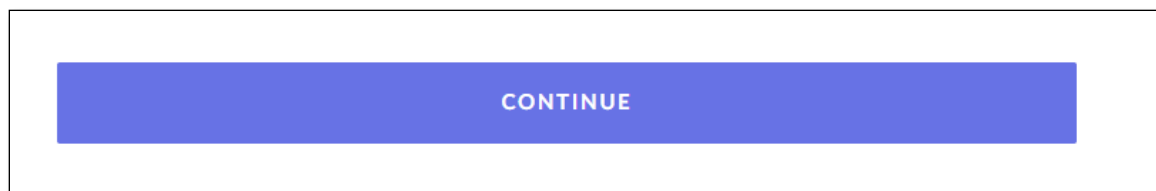
