## October 30, 2017 SECOND INJURY FUND STATUS REPORT

To Indiana's Workers' Compensation Community:

We are nearing the end of 2017 with the Second Injury Fund in the black. The fund has sufficient monies to pay its obligations through the end of December, leaving a chunk of change in reserve to offset next year's assessment.

The balance remaining in the Fund as of this date is \$3,383,380. Monthly payouts average roughly \$500,000, \$100,000 of which goes to replace prostheses. Disbursements for 2016 totaled \$6,298,675. In accordance with IC 22-3-3-13(c) (2), an assessment is appropriate for 2018, as the assets in the Fund on or before November 1st are less than 135% of the previous year's payments.
